Entry Information

- No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- The show/trial secretary is unable to accept or cancel entries after the specified closing date/time.
- Tendering of a NSF cheque as payment of entry fees shall be considered to be a non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
- Entrants must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs except as outlined in 8.2.5 of the Conformation Show Rules. The show/trial secretary will not be responsible for checking the accuracy of entries. Errors should be brought to the attention of the show/trial secretary.
- The show/trial committee reserves the right to refuse entries subject to CKC rules.
- In the case of non-acceptance of an entry, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non acceptance.
- Telephone, facsimile and e-mail entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the CKC may otherwise authorize.
- Please use separate entry forms for conformation and obedience. If copying the entry forms, they must be the same size as the original.
- The address section of the entry forms should be completed for every entry to facilitate the speedy mailing of the judging schedule and receipts.
- If you wish your entry to be acknowledged, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- The entry form must be completed in full. An incomplete entry form must be rejected by the Show-giving club and returned to the designated owner or agent.
- Every dog entered in a championship show or trial, except those breeds designated by the board, as being eligible to compete in the miscellaneous class, must be registered or eligible for registration in the studbook of the CKC.
- No dog under the age of six (6) months is permitted within the precincts of the show/trial, except, pre-registered puppies 3-6 months of age that are with the owner who has other dog (s) entered in regular classes of the show/trial. These puppies will not be listed in the catalogue but must be preregistered by the owner at or before the closing date and time of entries.

Notice to Exhibitors

1. These shows and trials are being held under the Canadian Kennel Club Rules.

Exhibitors should pay particular attention to all chapters pertaining to rules of the shows/trials.

General Information

- On the day of the show/trial, the show/trial superintendent will be in complete charge of the show/trial.
- Receipts must be presented at the entrance of the show/trial premises. Only dogs properly entered in the show/trial will be admitted.
- The building will be opened 1 (one) hour before the start of the show/trial.
- Dogs may be removed from the building when not required for further judging.
- Dogs **must not** be left in the building overnight.
- Judging will proceed without any dog not present when called by the ring steward.
- The show/trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and the exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs or patrons.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show/trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- We regret that trailer hook ups **will not** be available at the show/trial site.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities.

The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation. The Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

- The show/trial grounds are defined as the confines of St. Kevin's Parish Hall ,
Main Road, Goulds, NL
- The authorities of the shows/trials may decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show/trial building on account of viciousness or disease.

- There will be a Veterinarian on call throughout the shows/trials

No one shall have any claim or recourse against the organization holding the show/trial or any official connected therewith for the refusal of an entry.

Classifications

Every dog entered in a show or trial must be entered in one of the regular classes (below), or as “Specials Only” or entered for “Exhibition Only”.

Conformation

- Junior Puppy Dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.
- Senior Puppy Dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.
- 12-18 Months Dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.
- Canadian Bred Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.
- Bred by Exhibitor Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/co-owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further shows.

Open Class All dogs.

Specials Only Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy is eligible.

Exhibition Only All dogs entered for “Exhibition Only” shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered in competition.

3 – 6 Month No dog under the age of six (6) months is permitted within the precincts of the show/trial, except, pre-registered puppies 3-6 months of age that are with the owner who has other dog (s) entered in regular classes of the show/trial. These puppies will not be listed in the catalogue but must be pre-registered by the owner at or before the closing date and time of entries.

Exhibition Only - All dogs entered for "Exhibition Only shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered in competition.

A separate entry form is required for each class in an obedience trial. To facilitate setting up jumps for open and utility, please state the jump height requirement on each entry form.

A bitch in season **may not** be entered in an obedience trial. Entry fees will be refunded for a bitch in season provided a veterinarian's certificate to this effect is presented to the show/trial secretary prior to the start of the first trial.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINT RATINGS

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated dog-awarded winners shall be:

Dogs competing (including dog awarded winners):

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from their ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

Dogs competing	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

Additional points are awarded at the **Group Level**:

In no case may a dog earn more than **5** (five) points at a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion it must win at least 10 points under 3 different judges, which includes at least one 2-point win. This 2-point win must be at the breed or group level.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Junior handling will be held Saturday and Sunday during the lunch break. Competitors are asked to please fill out the pre-registration form included.

Class Structure

Pewee

Children up to 6 years of age. This is a non-competitive class.

Junior Novice

Handlers 6 to 11 years old who have not achieved four first placements in this class.

Junior Open

Handlers 6 to 11 years of age who have achieved four first placements in the Novice class or any handler wishing to enter this level. Once the handler has entered and competed in the Open class, he cannot compete in the Novice class again.

Senior Novice

Handlers 12 to 17 years of age who have not achieved four first placements in this class.

Senior Open

- Handlers 12 to 17 years of age who have received four first placements in the Senior Novice class.
- Handlers who have previously competed in an open class in either junior or senior.
- Handlers who have progressed through the Junior Open class and feel that they have enough experience to compete at the level.
- Handlers (junior or senior) who have received some type of monetary consideration for showing a dog.
- Once a handler competes in the Senior Open class, s/he cannot compete in any other class.

Best overall is optional at the discretion of the host club.

Junior handlers are eligible to compete in the above class structure from their eighth birthday until they reach their eighteenth birthday.
