Listing fees are payable with the entry fee for dogs that do not have their individual registration numbers. Official CKC entry forms must be used.

FAXED ENTRIES MAY BE PAID BY VISA (we do not accept Mastercard) There is a 10% processing fee charged on each VISA transaction ~ therefore it is to your benefit to make all entries at one time. **PLEASE NOTE: This still applies "per transaction" not per dog.**

To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show Sec't after closing date or when entry limit is reached. Entry fees payable by cheque, money order, bankdraft or cash. All cheques to be made payable to **CHALEUR CANINE CLUB. NO POST DATED CHEQUES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** NSF Cheques are subject to an additional charge of \$25.00 plus bank charges.

ATTENTION U.S.A. EXHIBITORS

Please purchase a Bank Draft or Money Order payable in CANADIAN FUNDS for the FULL AMOUNT of the entry. Please do not mark cheques "PAYABLE IN CANADIAN FUNDS" or "AT PAR" as such items cannot be cleared through the banks and will be returned. EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and enter Canada for the purpose of participating in CKC events will require an ERN. To obtain an ERN please do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate, reflecting current ownership, e.g. an AKC registration certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$50.00 plus 5% GSTax ~ in Canadian Funds ~ to the Canadian Kennel Club, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, Etobicoke, Ont M9W 5Z9. Phone (416) 675-5511, Fax (416) 675-6506. Fax requests for ERN are accepted. Please indicate your VISA/Mastercard number, expiry date and name & address of cardholder.
3. Ensure that you provide full return name & address to enable the CKC to forward the ERN to you. The ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day a dog entered a CKC Event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed" (and the listing fee paid), however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days of the Event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores

PRIZE LIST

Suitable prizes & Rosettes will be offered each day for the following: Best In Show, Best Puppy In Show, Group 1st Puppy In Group. Rosettes will be awarded to dogs placing 2nd through 4th in Group. Best of Breed and all other class winners will receive flat ribbons.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING: * 1 2 3-5 6-9 10-12 13+

POINTS ALLOCATED: 0 1 2 3 4 5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS. The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group. As Follows

A class dog awarded BEST IN SHOW at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the Breed or Group Level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show.

CONFORMATION CLASS

The following official CKC classes divided by sex will be provided.

- * PUPPIES 3 –6 months – dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months on the day of the show
- JUNIOR PUPPY - a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
- SENIOR PUPPY - a dog between 9 months and 12 months on the day of the show.
- 12 – 18 Months - a dog between 12 months and 18 months on the day of the show
- CANADIAN BRED - A dog that was born in Canada.
- BRED BY EXHIBITOR - A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
- OPEN CLASS - All dogs.
- SPECIAL ONLY - Dogs who are Canadian Champions only.
- EXHIBITION ONLY - dogs 6 months and over not in competition

*Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular classes. Puppies in this category may NOT compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes including parades nor are they required to be listed in the catalogue. The Club has restricted the number of entries in this class to 30 per show.

MOVING UP TO SPECIALS – CONFORMATION

A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Sec't IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more all-breed shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

TRAILER & RV PARKING

Trailer & RV parking will be available on site at a cost of \$20.00 for the weekend. Request must be made with Entry and must be accompanied by PAYMENT IN FULL.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in
2. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date
3. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show, and its precincts. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
4. **No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.**
5. The SHOW SUPERINTENDENT WILL BE IN COMPLETE CHARGE OF THESE EVENTS.
6. Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have his/her dog at ringside when called
7. Any dog excused by the Judge, Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any awards for the remainder of the show
8. "Puppy" or "Dog" For Sale signs, will not be allowed in the building.
9. The Chaleur Canine Club will use all due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs & exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of an accident or any misfortune to either dog, exhibitors or patrons.
10. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show no refund or return of entry fees will be made.
