Canadian Bred	Dogs born in Canada (Champions of any country excluded)
Canada Bred by Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over not in competition

Conformation - Move to Specials A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to 'Specials Only' providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary **IN WRITING** at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

Champions and Championship Points - Chapter 15 SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

Listing fees are payable with the Entry Fee for dogs that do not have their individual registration number at closing date. **A Litter registration is not acceptable. Official CKC Entry forms MUST** be used. If other forms are used they must be of the same size and have the information in the same order. NO POST DATED CHEQUES accepted.

Points Are Not Awarded to Incorrect or Incomplete Entries

- When a dog is co-owned, the names of all owners must appear on the entry form.
 - Enter the dog under its registered name, not its call name or another dog's name. The only exception is with listed dogs where the name may change upon registration.
 - A foreign dog registered in another country must be entered under its registered name in the country of origin.
 - All entry forms must be legible - type or print the information.

- All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official CKC entry form. **Please type or print clearly.**
 - **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.** Agents and handlers please note that **full name and address of owners MUST** be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. **(Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)**
 - **Entries will be rejected and returned if a credit card authorization is declined by Visa or MasterCard.** Payment must accompany all entries before they can be accepted.
 - Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
 - To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to cancel any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing time and date.
 - Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) To obtain an ERN number simply do the following: 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number. 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. 3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you. 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature. This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. Junior Handling

Junior Handling will be held on **Sunday** (REGULAR) in the first available ring. Registration: 11:00 A.M. at the Secretary's Table. **\$2.00 per entry** Dogs competing in Junior Handling **must** be entered for that day in one of the Regular Classes or on Exhibition only. Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the show secretary at the show,

Dogs being used in the competition **MUST BE OF APPROPRIATE SIZE AND TEMPERAMENT FOR THE JUNIOR HANDLER**

Classes offered:

PEE WEE: 4-6 inclusive. Non-competitive.

JUNIOR NOVICE: 7-10 years incl. who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

JUNIOR OPEN: 7-10 Years incl. who have won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE: 11-14 years incl. who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

INTERMEDIATE OPEN: 11-14 years incl. who have won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

SENIOR NOVICE: 12 years & up to 18 who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

SENIOR OPEN: 12 years & up to 18 who have won 6 first places with competition, or for any handler who has progressed through Jr. Open and feels he can compete at this level. Also for those who have received monetary sums for handling.

The most up to date rule amendments concerning age divisions which came into effect on January 1, 2006 are also posted at www.ckcjuniorhandling.ca in the NEWS section of the Home page.

Parents & Juniors: Please read the rules carefully so that you or your child will be entered in the correct class for upcoming 2006 shows! Keep in mind, that whatever age your child is AS OF DEC 31, 2005 This will be the age category that your child will fall into for the competition year of 2006. The Senior Category child is now eligible to compete in Junior Handling (Senior Classes) until the day he or she turns 18 years of age. The child ages out when he or she turns 18, so now they will not miss a whole year if he or she turns 18 at the end of that year.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All Judging will commence at 9:00 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later start time. All Group Judging will commence on completion of Breed Judging within each Group. PROVIDING TIME ALLOWS, A break at the end of each group will allow for photographs to be taken. No two groups will be judged at the same time.
2. The Oromocto Kennel Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
3. Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our shows, however, please do not allow them to be unsupervised.
4. The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these Shows.
5. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. (Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules)
6. No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Section 4.1.6, Dog Show Rules)
7. No person shall enter or exhibit a dog under a judge where that judge has owned, conditioned, sold, handled, held under lease or boarded within 6 months prior to the date of the show at which he officiates as a judge. This rule shall apply regardless of whether the judge benefited in any way from any of the aforementioned activities. It is the responsibility of the owner to see that the rule is not violated. (Section 4.1.7, Dog Show Rules)
8. Double Handling" will not be tolerated. The Superintendent reserves the right to request those exhibitors doing so to leave the site.
9. "Puppy for Sale" and "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted on the site.
10. The Oromocto Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show site.
11. There will be no prong or spike collars permitted at this venue. Abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.
12. All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean-up on the show site and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling. Anyone caught not cleaning up after their dogs WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM SHOWING their dog or dogs at this event.
13. Dogs not entered in competition or on exhibition are not permitted within the precincts.
14. there will be portable washrooms only for show exhibitors.
15. If you are planning on using air conditioners, fans etc., please supply your own power i.e. generator. We cannot guarantee power or water at the show site.

Accommodations have limited rooms for animals, be sure to mention you have dogs.
