PawsWay is free to the public – there is no admission charge. Plus it welcomes dogs and even includes Toronto's only pet friendly cafe, Williams Coffee Pub, where you can enjoy teas with your Havanese or biscotti with your Scottie!

Dedicated to responsible ownership, education, entertainment, and instruction, PawsWay is potentially the most exciting initiative to affect our dogs. In many ways, some members of the canine community have failed our pets and their potential owners by not educating them. If a dog ends up in a shelter or is given away, it is because the owner either chose the wrong breed, or bought a dog on a whim, and just wasn't taught or educated.

And when a person chooses the wrong breed, it is always the animal that suffers or is discarded. Through its educational programmes, PawsWay hopes to make a difference.
