GENERAL INFORMATION

Payment: Please make all cheques or money orders payable to the Nova Scotia Duck Toller Retriever Club. A listing fee \$8.92 must accompany payment if the dog entered does not have an individually registered C.K.C. number or an E.R.N number.

U.S. entrants may pay fees by money order made payable in Canadian funds or personal cheques in U.S. funds for the full amount of the fee. Personally discounted cheques will not be accepted. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par" as these are not readily cleared by the banks.

Tendering a NSF or post-dated cheque will be considered non-payment of fees and will subject the issuer to a \$15.00 handling fee and possible disciplinary action by the C.K.C.

A competitor may enter more than one dog.

Due to the limited entry, we will only accept entries by Canada Post mail only, with one entry per envelope. Courier delivery of any kind is not accepted.

Entrants will be notified by phone or email that their entry has been received.

Draw for Entry: A random draw of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine placement in the test or on the Alternate list.

The drawing for entry will be held at 6:00 pm on Friday, 21 September 2018, at Tim Hortons, #401, 18682 Fraser Highway, Surrey BC V3S 7Y4. Anyone is welcome to attend the draw.

Following the draw, positions will be assigned following Rule 2.2.4 – option 2. Once the limit has been reached, all remaining entries will be assigned a position on an alternate list. Entrants will be notified by phone or email that their entry has been received and which position their entry occupies. Entry fees will be returned within 10 days of the test to alternates who did not participate.

Rule 2.2.4 Option 2:

- 1. Specialty breed without a title
- 2. Other breeds without a title
- 3. Specialty breed with a title
- 4. Other breeds with a title

Meeting place and draw for tracks on the day of the event: 7:00 am on Sunday, 7 October 2018, at Campbell Valley store.

Participants and spectators will meet at 7:00 am at the Campbell Valley store, 790 176th street, Surrey. B.C. where the draw for tracks will take place. Any primary entrant who is not present at this time will forfeit their position to the first alternate present.

Bitches in season:

They may compete, but must run last. Please advise the test secretary on your arrival.

Awards and no-host lunch:

A no-host lunch will be held following the tracking test, at which time the Judge will present ribbons and provide feedback on all the teams.

Refunds:

When an entry is withdrawn after the closing date, refunds will only be permitted when the vacant track is accepted by an alternate. If a position becomes available, alternates will be contacted in catalogue order and asked to accept or decline the position. If declined, the next person on the list will be contacted.

Rule 14.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The tracking test committee chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
