Listing Fees are payable with the entry for dogs that do not have their individual CKC Registration Number, or CKC Event Registration Number (ERN) or (PEN). **Official CKC Entry Forms MUST** be used

Faxed Entries will be accepted using VISA (we do not take any other Credit Card). There will be a 10% fee charged per transaction (not per dog). Fax Number is: 1-506-546-3881. To use any other credit card you must enter through The Entry Line (see below).

No post dated cheques will be accepted. A post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fee and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention USA Exhibitors: Please note that due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par", they will NOT be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You!

NON-MEMBER PRTICIPATION FEE

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club.

The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.

In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.

The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

Entry Fees will be refunded for bitches that come into season after the closing date. Entry fees will also be refunded for dogs/bitches that pose a threat of communicable diseases on the day of the trial. To obtain either of these refunds a letter from a Veterinarian must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of the trial.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible to compete in these Trials, a dog must be registered with the CKC and have a CKC Registration Number, an ERN, PEN or Misc Certification Number, or be eligible for the same. Dogs may be spayed or neutered and/or debarked. Dogs must be 18 months of age or older. Dogs may not be lame. These Agility Trials will be held outdoors at Riverside Dog Training Academy, Shediac River, New Brunswick. The surface is grass. The precincts of these trials will be the ring and 10 feet surrounding it.
