

ORIENTAL DOG SHOW AND CELEBRATION: SEPTEMBER 15, 16, 2012

PawsWay, 245 Queens Quay West, Toronto, is the world's first educational centre for dogs (and cats). The 16,000 square foot, fully air conditioned building, right on Lake Ontario, is part of Harbourfront, the tourist centre that receives 17 million visits per year.

On September 15 and 16, PawsWay will present a dog show, limited to the Oriental Breeds of dog.

Eight breeds will be judged on Saturday September 15th. They are: Chow Chow, Chinese Crested, Pug, Akita, Japanese Spaniel, Japanese Spitz, Shikoku and Shiba Inu.

The remaining seven breeds will be judged on Sunday September 16th. They are: Lhasa Apso, Tibetan Mastiff, Tibetan Spaniel, Tibetan Terrier, Pekingese, Chinese Shar Pei and Shih Tzu.

The judge will be the renowned Pekingese breeder and international judge, Mr. Michael Hill.

There will be a limit of 75 dogs per day.

Cash prize for Best in Show will be \$2012. Each Best of Breed will receive \$50. Every exhibitor will receive a "goody" bag full of surprises. Several arm band draws will be conducted each day, again with excellent prizes. Other exceptional prizes, still in negotiation, will be offered. Stay tuned.

Vickie Barrett www.mjnshowservices.com is the show secretary. All major prizes will be accompanied by large specially designed rosettes. This is not a CKC show, although basic CKC rules will be followed. However, by offering money, rather than points, and significant armband draws to encourage all dogs to attend and thus promote their breed, the show will be simpler, kinder, and much more fun. There will not be a champion class – dogs will be judged in their age groups.

We welcome all breed clubs and will provide a table free of charge to each club to promote their breed. There will be a cavalcade of the Oriental breeds each day. This is a wonderful opportunity to promote your breed. There is an Asian festival at Harbourfront that weekend, so we expect many visitors.

PawsWay is the world's first educational centre for dogs and cats, located at 245 Queens Quay West, at Harbourfront in Toronto. The 16,000 square foot facility is dedicated to responsible pet ownership. It is entirely dog friendly, and within PawsWay's walls is Toronto's only pet friendly restaurant, Williams Coffee Pub. It is also the permanent home of the Purina Animal Hall of Fame. Each weekend different types of educational programmes are presented. Free to the public, PawsWay is funded by Purina's Pet Legacy Project.
