CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Baby Puppy for dogs between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete

for championship points

Junior Puppy for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred By Exhibitor for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder

Veteran (7-10 years) for any dog, 7 years of age but less than 10 years of age on the day of the show. These dogs do not

compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed.

DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED

Veteran (10+ years) for any dog, 10 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but

the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED

Specials Only for dogs which are registered individually, in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN

number and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is

not allowed.

Exhibition Only Stud Dog & Get Brood Bitch & Progeny for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog & Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only. Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ERRORS IN ENTRIES

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the order/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show. When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$60.00 plus 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee - (24-12-3)

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$60.00
 + 5% GST.
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the
 non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- "These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"
- Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

CKC Rule 19.7- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any
participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly
report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on
receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and
catalogue.
