Pass Creek Regional Exhibition Grounds, near Castlegar, BC. Outdoors. Limited Shade. Directions are on page 4 of this document.

AWARDS

AAC qualifying ribbons will be awarded, as will AAC 1st to 4th placement ribbons.

MOVE UPS

Move-ups from prior trials must be reported no later than one week prior to the trial. Please contact the Trial Secretary. We will attempt to accommodate same day move-ups when possible.

FOOD

There is no food onsite. Restaurants are about 20 minutes away. There is potable water.

AGILITY EQUIPMENT FAMILIARIZATION

Before the first agility run on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Open to all dogs.

VETERINARIAN ON CALL To be announced

CAMPING

DRY CAMPING available on site at a cost of \$10 per night. Camping available Thursday and Sunday nights as well.

CRATING AND SET-UP

The site will be available for set up after 12 noon on Friday. Lost or damaged personal property is not the responsibility of Love 2 Play or the site management. Valuables should not left in your vehicle.

<u>NEW RULE AFFECTING ALL COMPETITORS</u>: All dogs must leave the ring under control; this means the dog needs to be put on a leash before leaving the ring and/or picked up to be carried out of the ring. Dogs who leave the ring or catch area NOT under control after their run may be given a verbal warning and/or faulted -- from 5 faults to an E -- at the judge's discretion.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following rules regarding entry:

- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in these trials. Where a bitch comes into season after the entry of the bitch has been submitted, a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the Trial must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the Trial, whereupon the entry fees will be refunded.
- All dogs must be registered with AAC to compete in the agility trial. It is your responsibility to provide the Trial Secretary
 with your dog's AAC number prior to the closing date or your entry will be rejected.
- **Safety** shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- Obstacles and stations shall be chosen from those described in the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to this organization's specifications.
- It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behaviour of their dogs and/or children. Any
 competitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive
 behaviour may be asked to leave. NO REFUND of fees will be paid.
- All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when they leave the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior when leaving the ring will be disqualified and/or required to leave the trial site. NO REFUND of fees will be paid.
- Exhibitors must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great venue available for future dog events!
- There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/ injured dogs if the Trial Secretary is notified prior to the trial date and provided with a vet's certificate.
- Trial organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry and if an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any
 reason, they will not be issued a refund.

All competitors are expected to volunteer during the trial. These trials cannot happen without your ongoing support as volunteers. We are GRATEFUL for your help!

AAC RULES and CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

For a complete description of the AAC rules, regulations, performance guidelines, explanation of classes, etc. go to: http://www.aac.ca

Classes shall be scored under the provisions of Chapter 3 of the Agility Association of Canada [AAC] Rules and Regulations. Find the official descriptions, rules, and your dog's trial results to date at the AAC website .

Starters Level: The Starters level class is for dogs that have not earned the Agility Dog of Canada [ADC] title. A dog must achieve 3 qualifying Starters Standard runs under two different judges to be awarded the ADC title.

Advanced Level: The Advanced level class is for dogs that have earned the Agility Dog of Canada [ADC] title, but not the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada [AADC] title. A dog must achieve 3 qualifying Advanced Standard runs under two different judges to be awarded the AADC title,

Masters Level: The Master level class is for dogs that have earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada [AADC] title. A dog must achieve 3 qualifying Masters Standard runs under two different judges to be awarded the MADC title.

Special Classes: These classes are open to all dogs but are intended for dogs where -- for any reason the handler elects -- it is best for the dog to jump one jump height lower than the dog would at its regular jump height. A dog may no longer compete in Regular titling classes after being entered at an official trial in any Special class, except that they may move to Veterans.

Veterans Classes: These classes shall be for dogs seven years of age or older, or for dogs five years of age or older who have competed in the Specials Agility Classes for a minimum of one calendar year. A dog may no longer compete in Regular titling classes after being entered at an official trial in any Veteran class.

Junior Handlers: Each handler requires a Junior Handler ID card. The Junior Handler program is open to all children up to and including 17 years of age, and is designed to encourage youth enjoyment of the sport of agility. Junior handlers will use the same Standard/Advanced/Masters course (appropriate for their level) as the regular competitors, except some things will be judged differently, and junior handlers are eligible for certificates of accomplishment upon completion of each level. Children do not have to use this program – they may compete as a regular competitor, but if they do enter this trial under the Junior Handler program, they may not (at this trial) run a dog in the regular events as well.

Standard Runs: In a Standard run the dog and handler complete a flowing course demonstrating an ability to perform all obstacles and handle a sequence with changes of side and challenges.

Gamblers Runs: This game demonstrates the handler's strategy and the dog's ability to work at a distance from their handler. The object of the game is to accumulate as many points as possible during the opening sequence and successfully complete the distance sequence, the Gamble.

Snooker Runs: This game demonstrates the handler's and dog's versatility as they work together. The object of this game is to accumulate as many points as possible by successfully completing as many obstacles as possible in the prescribed order.

Jumpers Runs: This game demonstrates a dog's natural jumping ability. The dog is required to complete a course comprised of jumps and tunnels.

Steeplechase Runs: This game is offered at only one level, but is open to dogs at all agility levels [Starters, Advanced, Masters]. It demonstrates the dog's ability to run and jump at high speeds while maintaining control on the A-frame and weave poles.

Directions to the Exhibition Grounds

From Downtown Castlegar: Go through North Castlegar and bear right then left over the bridge towards Robson. After the bridge you turn left to Robson (Broadwater Rd). You pass a turn off to Pass Creek Park on the right; the next right is Relkoff Rd, the road to Pass Creek Exhibition Grounds (there is a sign for the fall fair). Go down this road just a bit, the exhibition grounds are on your right.

From Grand Forks or Salmo direction: Continue past Castlegar and past the airport (on your right). After the bridge, there is a right turn and underpass to Robson. Take this road and continue about 3 km. You will pass 'Pass Creek Road' on the right (2.8km). You will take the NEXT right (Broadwater Road): it has a sign for "Robson". You pass a turn off to Pass Creek Park on the right; the next right is Relkoff Rd, the road to Pass Creek Exhibition Grounds (there is a sign for the fall fair). Go down this road just a bit, the exhibition grounds are on your right.

From Nelson: BEFORE you get to the airport, there is a sign to Robson and the road goes off to the right. Take this road and continue about 3 km. You will pass 'Pass Creek Road' on the right (2.8km). You will take the NEXT right (Broadwater Rd): it has a sign for "Robson". You pass a turn off to Pass Creek Park on the right; the next right is Relkoff Rd, the road to Pass Creek Exhibition Grounds (there is a sign for the fall fair). Go down this road just a bit, the exhibition grounds are on your right.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by AAC and Love 2 Play Dog Training (aka Love 2 Play Dog Sports) (the "Organizing Club") and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the "**Event**"), I, the undersigned, agree as follows: 1. I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.

2. I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.

3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my "**Related Parties**"), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC, the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the "**Personnel**") for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind. 4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless AAC, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers' fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by AAC, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:

(a) any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law; or

(b) aggressive behaviour by the Dog or any other dog under my control.

5. I have read, and do understand the rules of competition and the additional rules (if any) appearing in the trial schedule for the Event, as well as the policies of AAC pertaining to discipline (collectively, the "**Rules**"). I agree to abide by the Rules and to conduct myself and the Dog in accordance with the Rules. I understand that myself and/or the Dog may be subject to disciplinary procedures or sanctions for breach of the Rules and agree to respect and be bound by any disciplinary decision made by AAC.

6. I understand that AAC and/or the Organizing Club may, in the course of administering the Event or conducting its activities generally, collect, use or disclose my personal information and that any personal information collected, used or disclosed by AAC and/or the Organizing Club will be treated in accordance with AAC policy and applicable privacy and personal information laws. I hereby consent to the collection, use and disclosure by AAC and/or the Organizing Club of my personal information.

7. I have been given the opportunity to read and understand the terms of this Agreement before signing it, and have in fact done so. I understand that by signing this Agreement, I am restricting my legal rights and I sign this Agreement voluntarily and of my own free will.
