	3. Any Bull Terrier /Miniature Bull Terrier which has not completed a championship but has been awarded ROM points at a Specialty or supported show under a breeder judge is eligible to enter the Champion Class.
	4. Any Bull Terrier/Miniature Bull Terrier which has not completed the requirements for a championship of their country or not been awarded ROM points is eligible to enter the the appropriate age class; 6-9 mos; 9-12 mos; 12-18 mos or Open.
	5. An officiating judge shall not own, co-own, or exhibit any entry at the Bronze Trophy nor Don Cherry Trophy.

	2. The BTCA has granted ROM points for the Bronze Trophy Show to be awarded according to the ROM Rules of the BTCA.
	3. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
	4. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied with proof of payment. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entry was made.
	5. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE 8:00 P.M. ET, April 26, 2022 and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date & time.

Judging Procedure: Bronze Trophy and Don Cherry Trophy Competitions

- 1. One Judge will be assigned to judge the Dogs and the other will be assigned to judge the bitches.
- 2. Classes will be judged in order beginning with 6-9 mos. The winners of each individual class will be judged together to select an overall winner in Dogs and an overall winner in Bitches. **Only these two overall Winners** are eligible to go forward to compete against the Champions class for the Bronze/Don Cherry Trophy at which time a Best of Winners will be selected.
- 3. For the Bronze/Don Cherry Trophy all dogs will be judged as a group and all bitches will be judged as a group.
- 4. Judges must select a **minimum** of six finalists; at least three dogs and three bitches.
- 5. From the finalists each Judge shall select a WINNER and a RESERVE.
- 6. a) If the TROPHY WINNER AND RESERVE are of the same sex then each Judge will be asked to select a dog/bitch for Best of Opposite Sex.
  - b) If both judges select the same dog/bitch for Best of Opposite Sex then this dog/bitch will be declared the Best of Opposite Sex to the Trophy Winner.
  - c) If the judges select different dogs for Best of Opposite Sex then the REFEREE will select between the two dogs and declare the BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX WINNER.
- 7. After the Bronze Trophy Winner, Reserve and BOS have been chosen, The Best Opposite Color (Variety) of the Trophy will be chosen. This can be either sex.
- 8. Each Judge shall select his//her choice for BEST MOVER, from all of the entrants. If both Judges select a different dog/bitch, the REFEREE will select between those two to declare the MOVEMENT TROPHY WINNER.

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

#### Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

#### Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

#### Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

### GCHEX and Grand Champion Excellent Points

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

**Section 15.3.2** To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

**Section 15.3.3** Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

**NOTE:** Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.

Conformation Show Rules and Regulations	The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. <b>Section 4.7.3</b> of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
Moving Class Dog to Specials Only	<b>Section 8.9</b> of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.
	When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.
NEW – Moving Back to the Classes	<b>Section 8.10.5</b> A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.



### HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the even on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.
