In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Customers whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00 for each transaction declined. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$59.40. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel</u> Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

Attention Canadian Exhibitors!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. **The fee is** \$59.40 + 5% GST.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

CKC REGULAR CLASSES (divided by sex)

Baby Puppy: puppies 3-6 months of age. These puppies do not compete for championship points.

Puppies in this category may enter and compete in Sweepstakes.

Junior Puppy: 6 months of age & under 9 months
Senior Puppy: 9 months of age & under 12 months
12-18 month: 12 months of age & under 18 months

Canadian Bred: dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred by Exhibitor: owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner, co-owner and

breeder, co-breeder of the dog.

Open: for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC

Veterans: for any dog 7 years or older on the day of the show. *Note: Veterans dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.*

Specials Only: dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have an ERN (Event Registration Number) and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" Class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the C.K.C., but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a "Listed Dog" in this class is NOT allowed.

NON-REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES:

The following additional Non-Regular classes will be offered. Any dog entered in these classes **MUST** also be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only

Stud Dog & Get: Stud Dog and two or more (up to four) of his get. Sire and get need not be owned by the same person. Stud Dog must be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. **Brood Bitch & Progeny:** Brood bitch and two or more (up to four) of her progeny. Dam and progeny need not be owned by the same person. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Progeny must be

entered in a Regular class.

Brace: For two dogs, not necessarily of the same sex, handled on the same lead.

SWEEPSTAKES

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

TO COMPETE IN ANY SWEEPSTAKES CLASS, DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS, OR FOR SPECIALS ONLY. ENTRY IN JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED EXCEPT FOR PUPPIES AGED 3-6 MONTHS. 3-6 MONTH OLD PUPPIES MAY ENTER FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MOS.) CLASS OR FROM THE BABY PUPPY CLASS. CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED BY AGE AND SEX AS FOLLOWS:

3-6 months 6-9 months 9-12 months 12-18 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. The TFTCC will retain 25% of collected entry fees for expenses. The remaining fees will be distributed as follows:

 $1^{\rm st}$ in each class – 25% of entry fees for that class & a rosette

2nd in each class – 10% of entry fees for that class & a rosette

3rd in each class – 5% of entry fees for that class & a rosette

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS:

Section 20.2. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

** Dogs Competing	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 and over
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{**} includes dog awarded winners.

In order for a dog to be issued a CKC Championship Certificate the dog must: earn at least 10 Championship points under at least 3 (three) different judges, be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number, and have earned at least one 2 (two) point win at the breed or group level.

ENTRY AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules" and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the TFTCC has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these all-breed shows, obedience trials, agility trials or any of the associated Specialties, and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Toy Fox Terrier Club of Canada and associated Clubs, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have beencaused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
