EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$59.40 (plus GST or HST where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores. ENTRY INFORMATION

- All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official CKC entry form. Please type or print clearly.
- INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please note that full name and address of owners <u>MUST</u> be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 4. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time.

5. Only dogs entered may enter these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Dartmouth Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of and accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
- 2. The building will be open an hour before judging commences.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
- 5. No dogs will be allowed in the building overnight.
- 6. In no case may a dog under 3 months of age be allowed within the show/trial precincts.
- 7. "Puppy/Dog for sale" signs will not be permitted within the precincts of the show.
- 8. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 9. Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted in the building.
- 10. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- 11. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/handler to clean up after their dogs outside the ring and outside the building. Please make sure your x-pen area is clean before you leave.
- 12. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the DKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 13. The Dartmouth Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.
