**NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members .

### SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR BORDER TERRIERS

#### Regular Classes

**Junior Puppy** ~ puppies between 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show.  
**Senior Puppy** ~ puppies between 9 months and under 12 months on the day of the show.  
**12-18 months** ~ dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.  
**Canadian Bred** ~ a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.  
**Bred By Exhibitor** ~ dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.  
**Open Class** ~ for all Border Terriers  
**Veterans Class** ~ the Veterans Class is divided into three categories ~ they are as follows:  
**Veterans 7 years up to 10 years** ~ a dog at least 7 years of age but not including 10 years  
**Veterans 10 years up to 13 years** ~ for dogs at least 10 years of age but not including 13 years  
**Veterans 13 years and older** ~ for dogs 13 years of age and older  
**Specials Only** ~ for Border Terriers that are Canadian Champions only.  
**Exhibition Only** ~ all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular Class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular Classes and/or Parades.  
 Plus  
**Award of Merit** ~ At the judge's discretion, Award of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Award of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

#### POINTS

Chapter 20, Section 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show held under the CKC Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship Points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of Championship Points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of Championship Points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breeds awards Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set for above. **NOTE: In counting the number of dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation of Championship points.**

#### Non-Regular Classes

Dogs entered in any of these Non-Regular Classes **must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only. All Get and Progeny must be entered in an Official Class.**

**Stud Dog & Get:** Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud dog may be neutered.

**Brood Bitch & Progeny:** Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

**Brace Class:** Two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

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#### Unofficial Class

To enter one of these classes, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials, or Exhibition Only.

**Working Dog** ~ Shall be for a Dog with a CKC or AKC Earthdog Title or AWTA Title.

**Working Bitch** ~ Shall be for a Bitch with a CKC or AKC Earthdog title or AWTA Title.

#### PUPPY & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

These sweeps will take place Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2012

#### Puppy Sweeps

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

**6-9 months:** for Border Terriers at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months  
**9-12 months:** for Border Terriers at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months  
**12-18 months:** for Border Terriers at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

#### Veteran Sweeps

Veteran Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

**7 years up to 10 years:** Border Terriers at least 7 yrs of age up to but not including 10 yrs  
**10 years up to 13 years:** Border Terriers at least 10 yrs of age up to but not including 13 yrs  
**13 years of age & older:** Border Terriers 13 years of age and older.

#### Sweepstakes Prize Distribution

For both Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes the Class Winners will compete for Best In Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

**50%** of the Entry Fee for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class  
**15%** of the Total Sweeps Entry Fees will go to the Best In Sweeps  
**10%** of the Total Sweeps Entry Fee will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps  
**25%** will be retained for administrative purposes.

**A rosette will be awarded to first place in each class, with flat ribbons for 2<sup>nd</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup>.**

#### JUNIOR HANDLING

Junior Handling is offered at this Specialty. All Junior Handlers must handle a Border Terrier

#### JUST FOR FUN ~ NO FEE ~ NO APPLICATION NECESSARY

Following the judging of the Specialty judging we will have three "FUN" events: Best Otter Head, Breeders Class and Border Essentials

**Our Annual Best Otter Head** competition is open to any dog entered in the Specialty. Our judge, Patrick Glover, will select which Border Terrier among those present has the most typical "Otter Head".

**Breeders' Class** ~ The breeder of record enters a team with a minimum of 3 dogs and a maximum of 5 dogs, without distinction as to gender. The entrant must be the breeder of record for all exhibits.

**NOTE:** it is not required that the breeder of record be the current owner.

All dogs entered must be a minimum of 6 months of age ~ spayed and neutered dogs are eligible. Breeders may enter more than one team. Each team will be judged as a unit, standing and moving - to

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determine their overall quality, consistency and similarity, breed type and conformation to the breed standard.

Awards will be presented by our informal "judge", for Best Breeders' Team and Reserve Best Breeders' Team.

**Border Essentials**, is open to all Border Terriers present, regardless of whether they are entered in the Specialty or not. Perhaps your Border Terrier doesn't have the greatest head but maybe he has a wonderful carrot tail, or a hide and pelt to swoon over, so enter him for his strength and don't worry about the less than perfect parts. JoAnn Frier-Murza, Patrick Glover and Judy Todd our Earthdog judge will collaborate in determining which dogs have the most characteristic tails, hides and pelts.

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**DOG SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS**

A copy of the CKC rules pertaining to Conformation Shows is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the CKC regarding their event.

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.3 states "a Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out".

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.6 states "no person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action may be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act".

**BORDER TERRIER CANADA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY**

(adapted with permission from the Border Terrier Club of America Room Policy)

Border Terrier Canada (BTC) had adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future.

Any individual attending a Border Terrier Canada (BTC) sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. That includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTC Board of Directors:

1. May be banned from showing at the next BTC sanctioned event(s).

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2. May be subject to CKC sanctions.
3. Membership in BTC may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

Damages shall be defined as:

- (a) flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc)
- (b) any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground; and
- (c) any verified complaint by a BTC member.

BTC Room Regulations:

1. All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel or campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available wherever possible.
4. Dogs are to be allowed on hotel furniture/beds ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.
5. All owners/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.
