	3.	There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
	4.	Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials or unfinished Specials back to the classes is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. 	The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.
	A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN).
	<ul> <li>TCNs can be obtained:</li> <li>Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);</li> <li>By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or</li> <li>By contacting the Shows &amp; Trials Division Toll Free: 1-855-364-7252.</li> </ul>
	<b>Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN.</b> However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

Conformation Show Rules and Regulations	The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. <b>Section 4.7.3</b> of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
Moving Class Dog to Specials Only	<b>Section 8.9</b> of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.
	When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.
