Ms. McGowan considers herself a breeder first and a judge second. She was breeder-handler of the famous Sheltie Ch. Rorralore Sportin' Chance, CD, who at one time held the record for specialty wins. She has bred and shown Shelties, Dandie Dinmont Terriers, and Papillons under the Rorralore banner. Her homebred Papillon Ch. Rorralore Dainos was top-10 for a number of years and is proving a good sire. One of the kennel foundation bitches, Ch. Loteki Life of the Party, is a PCA Dam of Distinction, having produced 10 champions. Ms. McGowan's Dandie Dinmont Ch. Charlieshope Au Courant was a top-10 Dandie with three sons also in the top 10. Au Courant was a national-specialty and a Montgomery breed winner who produced six champions.

Ms. McGowan began judging in 1971. Her assignments have included four Westminster shows and numerous national and regional specialties in a wide variety of breeds.

Ms. McGowan is an honorary Life Member of the American Shetland Sheepdog Association and the Colonial Shetland Sheepdog Club. Other club affiliations include the Ladies Dog Club, the Dandie Dinmont Terrier Club of America, the Bay State Judges Workshop, and the Papillon Club of America.

Ms. McGowan is the author of The Shetland Sheepdog in America, an authoritative work on the breed.
