When you entered, you signified you have read and agreed to the information published in the Premium List AND any updated or changed information that may follow from the club and/or show secretary. We will be strictly following all Federal, Provincial and Local guidelines regarding holding public events. If any changes are required it will be sent out via Dogshow.ca notifications, and you will be responsible for being aware of the changes. Please read our Covid information multiple times- rule breakers will be immediately removed for the weekend with no refunds or warnings. Covid Protocol- so how does this dog show work?

You may only enter the entrance gate 30 minutes before your ring time.

At the entrance gate you will hand over a new waiver for each day for every person within the vehicle. Only Agents and assistants that are on the attendance list may enter, these must be arranged ahead of time by email with show secretary. We will deny entry to anyone else, no exceptions.

Temperatures will be taken for every person in the vehicle, stay masked within your vehicle during this.

Agents will receive a package with a designated wrist band for that specific day, all their armband numbers (Please know ahead of time your dogs armband numbers, there will be no physical catalogue available), and rubber band for arm. On day two if you previously got your numbers, you will only receive a new wristband. Assistants will receive a package with a couple of empty armband numbers, rubber band, and designated wristband for the day. No extra wristbands will be handed out, do not lose yours. Each day you will get a new wristband when you give a new waiver.

Please follow parking attendants to the parking area and remain in your car until just before your ring time. Please do not come to the ring more than 5 minutes ahead of your ring time. We will be allowing a maximum of 2 crates per agent ring side that must be removed immediately after finishing in the ring. There is absolutely no outside grooming, handlers with 4+ breeds of dogs may have a maximum of two small sized expens to be most efficient and keep the show going on time. Any exhibitor with less then 4 breeds may not bench outside of their vehicles. No exceptions.

There is no dog washing facilities on the show grounds- Please use local Petvalus or Spiffy carwash for washing options.

There will be a designated on leash pottying area for dogs, please pick up after your dogs and selves! There will also be human washrooms/or porta potties available.

The only times to be outside your vehicle is showing your dog within the ring, going to the bathroom, pottying your dog, fixing a correction or move up form with the secretary, or having a win photo taken.

After you are finished showing your dog you must immediately exit the show grounds. Best of breed/ Best puppy in Breed winners will be allowed back in 30 minutes before the Group ring time. And Group winners will be allowed back in 30 minutes before Best in Specialty Show.

Photography Information

Lianne Matieshin Photography will be there Saturday 8:45am-1:45pm and Sunday 8:30am to show end for official win photos and portraiture. Judges will be photo shopped in with Ribbons/Rosettes. Please try to stop by just after your ring times. Photos will available online afterwards for purchase.

Lisa Wysminity of Jumpstart imagery will also be the official candid ring photographer with photos available to purchase online afterwards.

Group livestreams will be available on Facebook daily- no exhibitor livestreaming allowed!

COVID RULES- MUST BE READ!

Masks must be worn correctly over mouth & nose. This is mandatory for everyone! This is mandatory anywhere within show grounds and in the rings, parking areas, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth and in any other location.

Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers. You must follow these!

Exhibitors have the option to pick up or refuse their placement ribbons as they exit the ring, NO RECYCLING of ribbons, if you touch it you take it.

Social Distancing 2 meters-6ft This is Mandatory in the rings, in parking area, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth.

The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations

Grooming tables used in the ring will be cleaned frequently.

No Public Catalogue will be available, know your numbers ahead of time!

There will be no social gathering allowed for "catching up", and chatting.

Come prepared. Be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks. Do not leave personal belongings at ringside.

Do not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc. behind, dispose of these items in the garbage bins.

Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instrument.

If exhibitors have 4 plus breeds please contact show secretary to arrange special parking area to stay longer amounts of time.

Any deviation from 100% compliance will result in ejection from the show without refund. We need 100% Cooperation from everyone. The health department, humane society as well as bylaw officers may arrive at the venue at any time without notice
