Starting Numbers "In a stake carrying championship points the starting dog of the first series will be determined by using the last two digits at closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE) S&P/TSX composite index two days prior to the first day of the trial or if the TSE is closed that day, the first day prior to that when the TSE is open.

Bitches in season may not compete and must be withdrawn. Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrous, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Field Trial Secretary prior to the start of the stake to qualify for a refund

Chapter 20, Section 5 of the Field Trial Rules & Regulations

Any person, participating in any capacity at the Field Trial held under these CKC rules, shall not be subject to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the trial, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively enforced. On report to the trial giving club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Field Trial Committee of the club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within 10 days after the trial, report to the CKC the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of the CKC shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.

Release and indemnification of Landowners

By entering this Hunt Test, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the test and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the test is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this

agreement is binding upon the participant, or his heirs, his executors and assigns.

Canadian resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay the non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC.
