CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. Building will accept dogs and equipment after 4:00 pm. Thursday.
- 2. Building will open at 7:00 am Friday, Saturday and Sunday and close at midnight Friday and Saturday. Exhibitors must vacate the building 1 hour after Best in Show on Sunday.
- 3. In Transit area available.
- 4. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept entries reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.
- 5. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.
- 6. TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 7. DIANA EDWARDS SHOW SERVICES, reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to C.K.C.Dog Show Rules.
- 8. Acknowledgement of Entry and judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
- 9. The person accompanying the dog must show Acknowledgement of Entry before the dog is allowed in the show and, unless a dog is entered officially, it will not be allowed in the show precincts, with the exception of dogs to be kept in the "In Transit" area. Show Precincts are the whole Memorial Centre building proper plus anything within ten feet of the outdoor rings.
- 10. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
- D.E.S.S. and the T.I.K.O. Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 12. Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC has ruled that, where there is a conflict between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.
- 13. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Changes or cancellation of any entry after closing date is prohibited.
- 14. If, because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- 15. To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loud-speaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- 16. We will have someone clean up during the show times, but remember they cannot be everywhere at once. Your co-operation in cleaning up after your dog is much appreciated.
- 17. By virtue of entering these shows -

I (we) agree to hold the Thousand Islands Kennel and Obedience Club (TIKO), and the owners of the premises on which this event takes place harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused, directly or indirectly, to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the afore-mentioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by the reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the afore-mentioned parties for damage be cause of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of the afore such a damage to property may be caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of the agrees to indemnify and so are the persons.


