post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes – it will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - * Effective March 2, 2020

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW FOR LABRADOR RETRIEVERS

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Veterans class will be divided into three classes: 7-9 years, 9-11 years & 11 & up

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Field Dog - shall be for any dog that has earned a title at WC Test, Hunt Tests or a placement at a Field Trial. **NOTE** This is now an official class. The dog does not compete for points but proceeds directly to Best of Breed. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging with winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Baby Puppy– shall be for puppies 4-6 months of age.

Stud Dog Class shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only.

Brood Bitch Class shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her Progeny only.

Brace Class - Both dogs must be entered in one of the official C.K.C. classes or for Specials Only. A brace shall be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait and stride, handled on one lead by one handler..

Altered Male Class – All sexually altered males, regardless of age will be judged together.

Altered Female Class – All sexually altered females, regardless of age will be judged together.

Winner of each of these two divisions competes for **Best Altered**

Generation Class – Sire or Dam with two generations of get.

Note: All Non-Regular Class will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 4 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

Baby Puppy Class for Labradors at least 4 months of age up to but not including 6 months.

Junior Class for Labradors at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for Labradors at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for Labradors at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 up to 9 years for Labradors at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

9 up to 11 years for Labradors at least 9 years of age up to but not including 11 years

11 years of age plus for Labradors 11 years of age and older

For Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% remaining of the entry fees will be awarded to the class winner.

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes

Champions and Championship Points Chapter 21

SECTION 1 A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is not a member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards, legs, points, titles bring cancelled. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Children, accompanied by an adult, are welcome at our show, however, please do not allow them to disturb dogs without permission of owner/handler .
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show premises and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The ALRC and property owners will not be held responsible for any equipment left on the grounds overnight.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- The ALRC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume and liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the ALRC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- Only dogs entered in the Show will be permitted on the show premises.
- The precincts of the show shall be the fenced area of the rings and 3 feet surrounding the rings.

This could change Prior to our closing date. If it does and the borders close the show will be cancelled and entry fees will be refunded.

In addition we must be vigilant in observing provincial and regional guidelines regarding travel into and out of different zones that may be different.

At all times we must ensure that we are doing everything possible to keep our friends and communities safe.

Every person entering the property will be screened and will be refused entry if you are violating any provincial guideline regarding travel. If you are in doubt, check with the province. We respectfully request that if you cannot or will not comply with these guidelines, Do Not Enter or Attend! THERE WILL BE A

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN/IF REQUIRED.

Our Waiver must be signed by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Volunteers, Vendors, Family Members, Friends Etc. Contact tracing information must be provided for all who attend (name & phone number). Everyone must wear masks correctly over mouth and nose: Exhibitors, Judges, Stewards in the rings during judging. Masks will also be required anywhere on the property where social distancing (2 meters) cannot be maintained (e.g Washrooms).

Social distancing (2 meters) is Mandatory in the rings, under the tents, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up, at the Photographers booth.

Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers. Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the ring. NO RECYCLING of ribbons. If you do not want your ribbons, Please leave them on the table.

Exhibitors are encouraged to return to their set ups after they have exhibited their dog. Parking will be directed. Generators are permitted in the parking area, as are personal ex-pens, grooming tables, pop-up tents, portable picnic tables etc.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Show Site Access Process: The waiver will be emailed along with the judging schedule. You will be required to print off enough waivers so that every individual traveling with you has their own waiver. The Waiver(s) will be handed into the club upon arrival at the show site, attendance wrist band will be provided at this time only. It is recommended that each group provides a cell phone contact number upon entering that will be in use during the show. The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations. No indoor grooming area and power is not supplied. No grooming tables, crates or trolleys under the pavilion. No chairs under the pavilion. No public ex-pens. Be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, Bring personal use masks. Do not leave personal belongings at ringside. Do not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc behind. Dispose of these items in the garbage bins.

Avoid shaking hands, hugging or other physical contact.

Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
