Now the serious breeder, exhibitor, and fancier is able to evaluate each dog's temperament, and add the letters TT, to the dog's name.

- \* The temperament test is designed for dogs at least 12 months of age.
- \* During the test, dogs are on an approved collar and a 6 ft. lead.
- \* Dogs may not be under command or influence by the handler during testing.
- \* These temperament evaluations show a dog's reaction to his environment.
- \* A dog has either a good temperament or not, no matter what breed!
- \* All breeds of dogs show a different disposition based on breed characteristics.

The 10 subtests the Testers use to evaluate each dog are:

-  Behaviour Toward Strangers
  - Test # 1 Neutral Stranger
  - Test #2 Friendly Stranger
  - Test #3 Crowd
-  Reaction to Visual Stimulus
  - Test #6 Umbrella Test
-  Reaction to Unusual footing
  - Test #7 Footing
-  Reaction to Acoustic Stimuli
  - Test #4 Hidden Clattering
  - Test #5 Gun Test
-  Self Protectiveness/Aggressive Reaction
  - Test #8 Recognizes Stimuli
  - Test #9 Recognizes Threat
  - Test #10 Dog is Threatened
