Unless otherwise stated, fees are per dog, per class. All fees include HST and are in Canadian Funds. A listing fee is payable for all dogs entered at shows that do not have an individual CKC registration number or an ERN. All cheques and money orders are to be made payable to: Northwestern Ontario Working Dog Association and mailed or dropped off to the address listed above, or register online at Dogshow.ca for etransfer and credit card payment.

SHOW PRECINCTS: The show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for officials, judges, exhibitors and handlers.

These trials are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog. #### Limited Entry

OBEDIENCE: Entry in each obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging.

RALLY: Entry in each rally obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 15 dogs per hour less time for walk-throughs. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging.

Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

#### **Refund Policy**

If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

### **Directions to site:**

Enter Dryden from East or West on TransCanada Hwy 17, turn north at the lights at Hwy 601 (Boozhoo Rd). Pass the Petro Pass and turn left onto Scott St, the agricultural building is on the right.

MOVE UP: 6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 15 minutes before the start of the class. 6.9.3 The Trial Secretary shall amend the judge's book and the marked catalogue, which is to be sent to the CKC with the requests attached to the appropriate entry forms. 6.9.5 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or an Event Registration Number (ERN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

Trophy List Each dog acquiring a new title at any one of the trials will receive a rosette

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience and Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 19.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations and Section 17.7 of the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations states:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, chub official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Be courteous and always pick up after your dogs at the site and especially at your hotel/motel or campsite.
