**TRIAL SITE:** This trial will be held indoors on a dirt surface.

**AAC ID CARDS:**

If your dog does not have a completed AAC card, please order it well in advance (registration form available at: <http://www.aac.ca/en/Forms/Main/>). You must have your dog measured and your card marked with that measurement before checking-in.

**AAC JUNIOR HANDLER PROGRAM:**

You must obtain a Junior Handler Identification Number prior to entering the trial as a Junior Handler (available on the same link as above). Junior handlers can enter any event as JH. Please refer to the AAC Rule Book for all relevant regulations. Please clearly mark the runs as JUNIOR HANDLER and only use one form per Junior Handler – do not mix the form with an entry for regular AAC runs.

**CLASS CHANGE/MOVE-UPS:**

Next day move-ups will be allowed. Please report move-ups to scorekeeping table. Move ups from prior trials must be reported no later than midnight Sunday March 9, 2014 - Please email Joanie-Leigh of any move ups immediately [agileted@gmail.com](mailto:agileted@gmail.com)

### CAMPING:

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO CLOVERDALE AGRIPLEX:** From Hwy-99, take #10 hwy exit. Follow #10 hwy to 176<sup>th</sup>. Turn left to 62<sup>nd</sup> Ave. Fairgrounds will be on your right.

**From Hwy-1,** take 176<sup>th</sup> Exit (Cloverdale) south to 62<sup>nd</sup> Ave. You will see signs for the Cloverdale Agriplex (Fairgrounds), on your left. There is plenty of parking outside the building.

**REMINDERS TO COMPETITORS** Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- This event is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may effect the dog's physical or mental performance, or any dogs showing signs of aggression.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC.
- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, including during familiarization and course-walking. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.
- All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior upon exit of the ring may be disqualified and / or required to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND of fees shall be given.
- Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs. We need to keep this great new venue available to us and other dog clubs!
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made.
- If an exhibitor must be asked to leave the show grounds for any reason, they will not be issued a refund.
- **There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn, with the exception of bitches in season or sick/ injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.**

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by AAC and the **Pacific Agility Clan** (the “**Organizing Club**”) and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the “**Event**”), I, the undersigned, agree as follows:

1. I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
2. I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my “**Related Parties**”), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC, the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the “**Personnel**”) for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind.
4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event.
