GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES ELIGIBILITY: Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age and:

- (a) Are individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number),
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Eligible for registration with the CKC and have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed

Levels offered each day: INSTINCT & NOVICE & OPEN
Components offered each day: CONTAINERS, INTERIOR, EXTERIOR
Note: 2 components may be run back to back

ODOURS: INSTINCT & NOVICE – *WINTERGREEN*
OPEN - *WINTERGREEN and PINE*

ENTRY FEE: INSTINCT: \$20
NOVICE and OPEN: \$30 per component

MOVE UPS: Move ups for next day trial are allowed. Exhibitors must already be entered at their current level to move up.

RIBBONS & AWARDS

Double Ribbon awarded for Instinct passes
Flat ribbons for all Qualifying Scores
Rosettes awarded for Novice & Open Titles
Rosettes awarded for Top Qualifying Score for each component per class

If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$10) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test.

BORDER CROSSING: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Scent Detection Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club.

CKC REGULATION: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you

WAIVER

I acknowledge that I, all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the “CKC Dog Show Rules”, and that I am familiar with their content. I agree that the club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged. I agree to hold the Campbell River Dog Fanciers Society and their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by an person or persons, including myself, or on account of damage of property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in this trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
