Baby Puppy A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show. **Junior Puppy** A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show. **Senior Puppy** A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show.

12-18 Months A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show.

Canadian Bred A dog which was born in Canada.

Bred by Exhibitor A dog owned and handled by the breeder.

Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older

Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions.

Veteran Class. Dogs must be seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Exhibition Only Dogs 6 months of age and over not in competition.

Competition for Altered Dogs

These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Winners Male, Winners Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the

title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January — December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.

TELEPHONE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

It is your responsibility to verify the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date.

NOTEWORTHY FARM SHOW SERVICES, reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Dog Show Rules.

Identification cards and judging schedule will be mailed / emailed as soon as possible after entries close.

Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and the New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC, has ruled that where a conflict arises between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Changes or cancellation of any entry after closing date is prohibited.

In the event that the dog is absent, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified, or barred from competition by action of the bench Committee, no entry fees will be refunded.

To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loudspeaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

Only dogs eligible for registration with CKC may enter this show and trial.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered: **JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS -** This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 to 18 MONTH CLASS- This class shall be for any dog 12 months but under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder.

The handler MUST be the owner/co- owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must

handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

VETERAN CLASS – This class is for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. The first place

male and female will compete for Best of Breed and Best Veteran in Specialty. The winners of the Veteran

Classes DO NOT compete for Championship points. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

FIELD CLASS – This class shall be for dogs that have attained a title at a WC/WCI/WCX test or Hunt Test or

placement in a Field Trial. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event

Registration Number and has attained the required points for

Championship status. Note: A Listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided

the CKC Individual or Event Registration

Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only

Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY

CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as

dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but

may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

NON REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Any dog entered in the Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only on

the day of the show except Baby Puppy.

BABY PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of

the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed.

BRACE – This class shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily the same sex). A brace must be handled by one person on one lead.

STUD DOG & GET – This class shall be for a Stud Dog and 2 or more of his Get. Ownership need not be

identical. The stud dog may be spay/neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only.

The Get must be entered in a Regular class.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY – Shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog & Get

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age, which have been sexually

altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the

Altered class judging. This class will be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes. The first place winner from each sex will then compete for Best Altered in Breed and Best Opposite Sex Altered in Breed.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

To be held prior to Regular class judging, Saturday, September 25, 2021 A rosette will be awarded to all four placements in each class. The winner of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. First place winners in each class will receive 50% of class entry fees in that class. Best in Sweepstakes will receive a rosette, prize and 15% of the total entry fees collected. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes will receive a rosette, prize and 10% of the total entry fees collected.

Baby Puppy - 4 months and under 6 months

These trials are NOT open to Canine Companion Dogs (CCN) and are LIMITED.

OFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES The following class descriptions are from the CKC Rule Book. THESE OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS ARE OPEN TO RECOGNIZED AND LISTED BREEDS ONLY

No dog may be entered in both Novice "A" and Novice "B", Open "A" and Open "B" at the same trial. In determining class eligibility, if a dog shall have won a particular title before being entered or moved up, the handler shall have been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores for the required title. (However, a dog may continue to be exhibited for 60 days in a class after winning a particular title.) Dogs fulfilling the requirements for a title may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the show secretary at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.

PRE-NOVICE - The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Novice classes. The Pre-Novice class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person

may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 5 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of C.D. may enter the Pre-Novice class

NOVICE A - The Novice A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

NOVICE B - The Novice B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises.

NOVICE C - The Novice C class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title C.D. or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in Novice C indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs in the Novice C class are not eligible for High In Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE - The Novice Intermediate class is an elective class and earning this title is not a requirement to enter the Open classes. The Novice Intermediate class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a C.D. or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle the dog in all 6 exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial.

Dogs may be entered in the Novice Intermediate class in addition to any

other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

OPEN HA - The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class.

OPEN 18A -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.

OPEN HB - The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines

is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times.

OPEN 18B – The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.

UTILITY A - The Utility A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch. title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

UTILITY B - The Utility B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class.

The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines will be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each will be used approximately the same number of times.

UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

The following class descriptions are from the CKC Rule Book.
THESE OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS ARE OPEN TO
RECOGNIZED AND LISTED BREEDS ONLY

All dogs entered in the unofficial classes must be entered in one of the official classes or Exhibition Only.

VETERANS CLASS - The Veterans class shall be for any dog that has earned the title of CD or higher and is seven (7) years old or older on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice classes. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such case, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises.

OFFICIAL RALLY CLASSES

The following class descriptions are from the CKC Rule Book THESE OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS ARE OPEN TO RECOGNIZED AND LISTED BREEDS ONLY

No dog may be entered in both Advanced "A" and Advanced "B" at the same trial or Excellent "A" and Excellent "B" at the same trial.

RALLY NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC Companion Dog Excellent (C.D.X.) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges

that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification form the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY NOVICE B - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC Companion Dog Excellent (C.D.X.) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class.

However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY ADVANCED B - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC Companion Dog Excellent (C.D.X.) title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this case must be the owner, the co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class, A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or

exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY EXCELLENT B - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class, A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash except the Honor Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY MASTER - This class is for dogs that have earned the RE title. Any person may handle the dog in this class. Dogs must earn 3 qualifying scores of 85 points or more under at least 2 different judges.


