Qualifying teams from across Canada and the U.S. are competing for the title of Canadian Agility Champion. This prestigious event provides the highest level of competition and is a stepping stone to qualify for the World Championships, to be held next year in Johannesburg, South Africa.



Beban Park's sports grounds will be transformed into 9 competition rings, with Canada's top dogs running in different competitive events. All course designs are hidden and secret until construction. Further testing skill and ability in our champion teams. (obstacles include: jumps, teeter, weave poles, tunnels, etc.) The winning team is selected through the accumulation of points combined over the entire event.
