NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$25.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please note that the **full name and address of owners MUST be filled in** and to whom ID's are to be returned.

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CONFORMATION, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON CONFORMATION, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB.

NON MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled. Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC Members

Obedience Trial – Move Up- A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title, in accordance with Section 6.8 and 8.4 of the Obedience Rules, may be moved to the next level of Obedience competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial secretary, IN WRITING by the owner or handler, one hour prior to the opening of the first trial, trial schedule permitting.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023 Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN. There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN. TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Event Registration Number (ERN) All dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. Effective January 1, 2023, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN

BITCHES IN SEASON: A Bitch in season may not compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary BEFORE commencement of the trial receives a Veterinarian's Certificate. Refunds for any other reason will not be given.

Show precincts shall be the 4-H barn event space for the Obedience and Rally Events (The Rally ring will be sized as a 30' by 70' space), and the Somebeachsomewhere Pavillion for the Conformation Show Sat June 8th. No unentered dogs will be permitted with in the show or trial precincts during trial hours as outlined by the Judging Schedule.

Set up times for exhibitors will be listed in the judging schedule.

ENTRY IDs: A conformation of entry/Exhibitor ID and Judging Schedule will be emailed to the email address provided on the entry form no less than 7 days before the first day of trials. None will be sent by regular post mail; exhibitors are responsible for legibly entering their email on the form, and checking spam/junk folders for delivery.

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed. Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Baby Puppy Class - Dogs 4 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non regular class.

Brace Class – shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

Parade of Veterans – for any Collie(rough or smooth) that is, or over 7 years of age on the date of the Parade.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The official CKC classes, divided by sex, will be provided. Enter one category only: Junior puppy - a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show. Senior puppy - a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show 12-18 months - a dog between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of show Canadian bred - a dog which was born in Canada. Bred by exhibitor - a dog owned and handled by the breeder Open class - all dogs Veterans - all dogs 7 years of age or older. Dogs may be neutered. Specials only - dogs who are Canadian champions only Exhibition - dogs 6 months and over, not in competition Altered - dogs 6 months & over that have been sexually altered

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS - CHAPTER 15 SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

TEAM CLASS (Rally Only)

The Team class is open to any four dogs that have earned the title of RN or higher. It is not necessary that the same person own all dogs in the team or that they be of the same breed. A 5th dog may be entered to serve as an alternate; but the same 4 dogs must complete all exercises and at the same level. Indicate the level on the entry form for each dog, if jumps are required, height is calculated by smallest team member. Please provide the show secretary a list of team members.

OFFICIAL JUNIOR HANDLING

There will be Junior Handling Conformation Saturday June 8th. This is limited to Collies Only. There will be Junior Handling Obedience Sunday June 9th, during the lunch break. Any Breed may be used but any junior qualifying with a collie will be eligible to win an extra prize.

Registration will be at the Show Secretary's table in the morning, and must be done at least one hour in advance of the scheduled judging. Dogs competing in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the regular classes or in Exhibition Only. A fee of \$2.00 for Junior Handling is required at time of registration. Advanced notice of Obedience entry would be appreciated.

SPECIALTY CATALOGUE Catalogues will be available from show secretary on a pre-order basis only- \$ 8.00. There may be a few available for purchase at the show, but this will not be guaranteed. Catalogues will not be mailed to absent exhibitors.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 4 months up to but not including 18 months of age.

To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials or Exhibition Only.. There will be eight classes in all, divided by sex.

4-6 mths for dogs at least 4 months of age up to but not including 6 months.

Junior Class for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all eight classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

9-11 years for Dogs 9 years of age up to but not including 11 years.

11 years + for Dogs11 years of age and older

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

GENERAL INFORMATION

Set up for Obedience and Rally will begin Thursday at 4pm. In the 4-H building. There will be no show grooming in this building.

Set up for conformation will be in the SomeBeachSomewhere Pavillion. The conformation show will be held in this building Saturday June 8^{th} .

Everything must be removed from this building by 9pm after the show on June 8th.

VEHICLE UNLOADING INSIDE THE BUILDING IS RESTRICTED TO 4-8pm ON FRIDAY June 7th. The building will be open at 7:00 a.m. Saturday June 8th

NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.

- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.

Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their dog is no longer needed for further awards. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
The CCC will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.

- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and

obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, 19.7)

- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.7)

- The CCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the CCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.

- The precincts of the show shall be the entire building and it's entrances, as previously listed.

ACCOMMODATIONS The management of the following accommodations has specifically requested that your dogs be confined to crates when left unattended in rooms and should be cleaned up after when being exercised. Please be respectful with your dogs and clean up any messes!
