COVID-19 RULES AND PROCEDURES

The Alberta Lure Coursing Association is excited about taking on the challenge of holding CKC Lure Trial during this continuing pandemic. We are absolutely committed to offering you a safe event and will follow Alberta Government guidelines regarding gathering limits, physical distancing, and the wearing of face masks. If you are not fully vaccinated we would encourage you to consider the possible health implications to you and vulnerable members of our community

IMPORTANT: Please read and agree to all rules and guidelines regarding this event. By submitting entries to this Lure Trial you are declaring that you agree to the following strictly enforced rules and regulations. Please do not enter if you have personal or political reasons for not respecting what we must do to abide by the Alberta Government Covid-19 protocol to keep us all safe.

PARKING & EXHIBITOR BENCHING: Parking will be designated in accordance with social distancing guidelines and will be assigned as you arrive. Please inform the Field Trial Secretary by Closing Date if you have mobility issues that require special parking arrangements. Exhibitor benching will be at the vehicle parking site. Pop-Up tents may be set up in your space if needed. Because of Covid-19 Safety Rules - Exhibitors are requested to be self-sufficient while on the grounds. We will not be offering a concession; however, we will be having a catered Turkey dinner at lunch on Saturday. Caterers will serve food on disposable plates and will meet Covid requirements. Due to Covid we will not be having a Pot Luck. Seating will be 'bring your own' and social distancing will be required.

MASKS: This is an outdoor event. Masks are required 100% of the time in the Field Trial Secretary's area, at the line when your dog is coursing and in the Turkey Dinner service line. Masks are strongly encouraged at all other times REGARDLESS if you can or cannot social distance. We request that you bring your own mask, however, masks are available at the venue.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: Social Distancing must be diligently practiced, and all exhibitors will follow the direction of ALCA volunteers, Field Trial Secretary, and Field Trial Chair at all times. Wins are exciting but please ... no hugs or high-5 celebrations outside your bubble!

ROLL CALL PROCEDURES: Social distancing & Mask protocols are mandatory. Hounds to be gaited to check for soundness and adequacy of equipment for Field Trial Committee without breaching the social distance guidelines. ALCA will provide tissues and designated waste receptacle so that owners can swab females to demonstrate that they are not in season.

HAND WASHING STATIONS: Hand washing stations and hand sanitizer will be available to exhibitors and volunteers throughout the grounds – USE THEM REGULARLY. BE SELF SUFFICIENT: Please remember to bring personal face coverings, hand sanitizer, gloves, cleaning wipes, etc. for your own personal use.

VOLUNTEERING: Hosting this event in these times will require additional volunteers. We will designate breed running order so that everyone can take a shift volunteering to keep our venue safe and to ensure that Covid Protocols are maintained. We appreciate all volunteers – it takes a community to keep us all safe.

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN IT IS POSSIBLE. DEPENDING ON THE LEVEL OF THE VIOLATION, YOU MAY GET A FRIENDLY REMINDER OR YOU MAY BE ASKED TO PACK YOUR STUFF AND LEAVE IMMEDIATELY. ENTER THIS EVENT AT YOUR OWN RISK

We ask all our Volunteers and Exhibitors to make their own health and safety a priority. 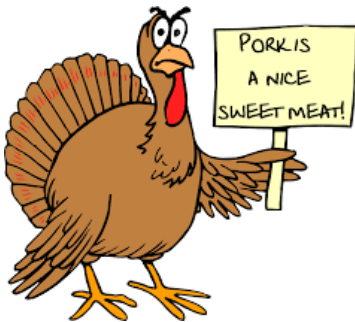

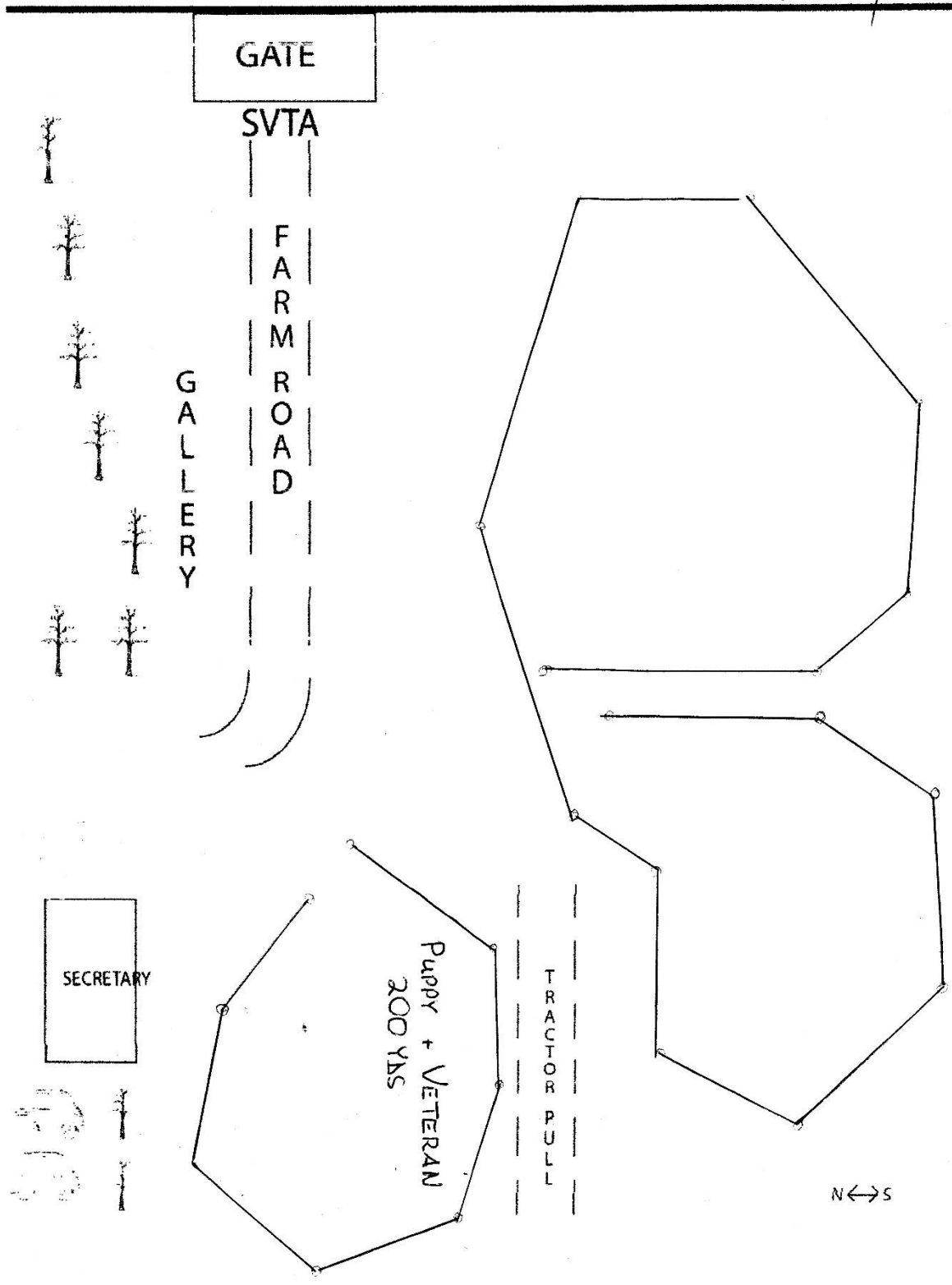
2021 AGGREGATE AWARD:

From South: Hwy 21 North to Township Road 534 (First road after Hwy 16 overpass)

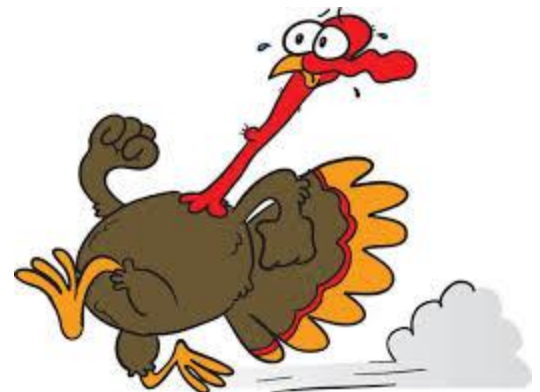
Turn right (east) onto Twp Rd 534 and proceed to Range Road 225 (First cross road)

Turn left (north) onto Rge Rd 225. Field is 1 km north on left side of road. Entrance has SVTA in big letters over the gate

From West: Hwy 16 east to Range Road 225 (First road after Hwy 21, approx 2 km)

Turn left (north) on Rge Rd 225

Field is 4 km north of Hwy 16 on left side of road. Entrance has SVTA in big letters over the gate.



EQUIPMENT AND FIELD CONDITIONS:

The field is a mown hay field, flat on the west side, sloping towards the road.

An electric drag will be used.

A continuous loop may be used for the Puppy and Veteran stakes.

CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION:

- Lunch will be a catered TURKEY DINNER. Sides and dessert will be supplied. **WILL NOT BE A POTLUCK IN THESE COVID TIMES!**
- Rolling inspection – check in for inspection as you arrive, with your dog(s). Inspection ends ½ hour after entries close each day (roll call). It is your responsibility to take your dog for inspection prior to roll call.
- **Lure Coursing is a strenuous athletic pursuit that requires your dog to be in excellent condition. Your dog relies on you to ensure this.**
- All hounds will be run in trios or braces, twice, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched, and their entry fee will NOT be refunded. No exceptions will be made.
- All handlers MUST use a slip lead when releasing their hounds.
- Hounds may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion.
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and will have their entry fee returned if notice is given to the secretary prior to roll call.
- The Chair may excuse any hound from competition for any reason deemed justifiable.
- A \$10.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for any hound loose on the field at any time between Roll Call and the completion of Best in Field.
- There is limited shade and no water available, so please come PREPARED.
- ALCA, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.
- All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club.
