Fee Structure

Entry Limit:

Entry Fee per Dog per Class (Pre-Entry) - \$35.00 Entry Fee for Second Class, Same Dog, Same Trial - \$25.00* Entry Fee per Dog per Class (Day of Trial) - \$45.00 Listing Fee (TCN) per Dog per Class - \$11.50 Exhibition Only per Dog per Day - \$15.00 Catalog (Pre-Order Only) - \$5.00

* This discount is for dogs who are entered in two classes in the same trial (Rally Advanced B & Excellent B, Rally Excellent B & Master, or Open B & Utility B Obedience only.) Pre-Entry only. Classes must be entered and paid for at the same time.

There will be a veterinarian on call throughout all trials via the Veterinary Specialty Center at 709- 221-7838.

The Rally Ring will be 40'x50'.

There will be no refunds for withdrawn entries after the closing date except in the case of a female in season. When a female comes into season after entries have closed, she may be withdrawn from the trial and refunded provided the Trial Secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the female was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.

Schedule of Events

Please note: Obedience may run before or after Rally depending on what best suits the schedule.

Saturday July 27th – Obedience Trial 1 & Rally Trial 1

Saturday July 28th – Obedience Trial 2 & Rally Trial 2

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Clean up bags and garbage bins are available for this purpose throughout the trial site. There continues to be those who do not take responsibility for their dogs, jeopardizing the club's access to this venue. For this reason, exhibitors who permit a dog to soil on the trial grounds without cleaning up will be denied entry to NKC shows and trials for one full calendar year.

Flat ribbons will be awarded for all Qualifying Scores, and rosettes will be awarded for all Highs in Class and Highs in Trial. Prizes will be awarded for both Highs in Trial. Prizes for High in Class graciously donated by our trial sponsor, The Wag Club.

Important Note: Volunteer Roles

We have a small but mighty dog sports community in NL running a substantial number of trials. The NKC Obedience & Rally Committee consists of only five people, many of whom also serve on other committees both for NKC and other local clubs.

While we appreciate that everyone would love to show up, trial, and head home – we'd love to do that too – we absolutely cannot continue to offer these trials without everyone's help.

Anyone who trials in Agility knows that the expectation is that all handlers volunteer for both set up and tear down of the trial, as well as take on other volunteer roles throughout the day. The same is true of Obedience & Rally trials.

We kindly request that all handlers make themselves available, if at all possible, to assist with set up Friday afternoon/evening, as well as for tear down Sunday afternoon.

We are also seeking volunteers to help with the following vital roles:

- Transporting equipment from Buckmaster Circle to the trial venue Friday afternoon (we need at least two pick up trucks and 6 physically able volunteers.) - Transporting equipment from the trial venue back to Buckmaster Circle Sunday afternoon (we need at least two pick up trucks and 6 physically able volunteers.)

- Making or purchasing, and delivering, lunch for the judge and three ring stewards (need one person each for Saturday and Sunday.)
