ENTRY INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: This is a limited Trial. Entries will close on Monday, August 8, 2011 at 8:00 pm OR when the limit of 30 Stock Dog runs per day has been reached. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MAILED – hand delivered and emailed entries **will not** be accepted.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Are allowed to compete

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All dogs must be at least 6 months of age, and registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate. CKC Miscellaneous Breeds cannot enter CKC events unless they have a Miscellaneous number.

CKC RULES: Rule books can be obtained from the CKC by calling their Order desk at: 1-800-250-8040

ENTRY FEES: \$55.00 for each Class entered. Entry fee includes lunch for the dog's handler.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries will be permitted provided regular trial entries do not fill the trial. **FEO entry fee is \$35.00** per dog for each class entered.

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however; they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks and we will not accept them as an entry. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase a bank draft or money order payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fee. Phone or fax entries will **not** be accepted.

NOTE: Effective January 1, 2011 - Non-Member Participation Fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee (\$57.60 + taxes). This is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor who should correspond with the CKC directly.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

RULES

1. We will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused, to dogs, exhibitors or property.
2. The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any trial held under CKC rules.
3. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward volunteer or competitor at the Herding Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
4. Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their dogs.
5. There is limited shade. Exhibitors are advised to bring their own shade, crates, etc.
6. Exhibitors must sign the waiver form (attached to this Premium List) before being allowed to compete.
7. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their dogs while they are on the trial grounds. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates except when competing.

From the 401:

Take Exit 295 Hwy 6 North (the Hanlon Expwy) for 15 km to Woodlawn Rd./Hwy 7.

Go East (turn right) on Woodlawn Rd. for 2.4 km to Woolwich Rd/Hwy 6 north intersection (there will be a Walmart on your left).

Go North (turn left) on Hwy 6 for 20 km to Fergus.

Follow signs through Fergus on Hwy 6.

After crossing through the main street in Fergus and up a hill, turn Right at Garafraxa St. E.

After 1.3 km, street becomes Wellington Road 19. Continue 4.4 km to Third Line .

Go South (turn right) onto Third Line.

6498 (Woolagon Farm) is 2nd farm house on the right after the golf course.
