

DIRECTIONS

From Toronto:

Take the 401 West to Hwy 6 North (the second Hwy 6 exit). At the first set of lights turn left (Wellington Rd 34). Follow this road to County Rd 35 and turn left. You will cross the 401. turn left on to the first road - Concession 2 - there is a sign for Paddock Corners. Turn left into the first driveway. Look for fire signs 2926 or 6924.

From London:

Take the 401 east to Townline Rd (exit 286). Once you come off the 401, you will come to a set of lights. Turn right at these lights and then left at the next set of lights. You will be on Lake Rd. Follow this road until you come to a stop sign (there will be a small lake on your right). Keep right at the stop sign and the road turns into Concession 2. You will come to another stop sign (county Rd 35). Go straight through the stop sign and turn left into the first driveway. If you come to sideroad 20, you missed the driveway.

From the North:

Take the Hanlon Expressway (Hwy6) south to Downey Rd (the YMCA is on the corner). Turn right and follow this road out of Guelph and into the country. Cross the 401, turn left at the first road (Concession 2). There is a sign for Paddock Corners. Turn left into the first driveway. The green fire signs are 6926 or 6924. If you come to sideroad 20, you have missed the driveway.

From the South:

Take Hwy 6 towards Guelph. This highway goes from 4 lanes to 2. You will go over a railroad bridge. Look for the sign for Leslie road and turn left (if you go into the little town of Morriston, you missed it). Follow this road to Side Road 20 and turn right. Sideroad 20 dead ends at Concession 2. Turn left. We are the 5th or 6th property on the right. Look for fire signs 6926 or 6924. If you come to the stop sign at County Rd 35, you missed it.

This is the first UKC agility trial in Ontario! Please help support us, and please volunteer to work – we will be holding a worker's raffle, and it takes many hands to put on an agility trial.

Dogs must be at least 12 months of age on the day of the trial.

Dogs may enter both Agility I and Agility II, but the U-AG II title will not be awarded until the requirements for U-AG I are completed. Dogs must already have the U-ACH title to enter Agility III.

AG-I and AG-II are divided. 'A' classes are for dogs that have not earned a title at that level. U-ACH points are only earned from the 'B' classes.

Mixed breeds welcome. All dogs entered must be registered with UKC.

Obstacles used will be as listed in the UKC Agility Rules.

Course familiarization is available for dogs entered in AG-I A and AG-II A - this is a walk thru on lead. Full details of 'course familiarization' is available in the UKC Agility rules.

Entry fee will be refunded for lame or in season dogs.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Veteran jump heights available for dogs over 7 years old.
Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.
The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in the trial.

HOW TO USE THIS ENTRY FORM:

- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC" Entry Form. You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one activity on the same weekend.
- Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event.
- Dog not UKC registered? Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com or call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020. (TL fees are non-refundable, non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration.)
- Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified. Make checks payable to host club.
- Obedience Trials, Agility Trials, Rally Obedience Trials, and Weight Pull events are open to all UKC recognized breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number. The Coursing Aptitude Test is open to all UKC registered and Mixed breed dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number.
- We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember:**
 - All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Limited Privilege number.
 - All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
 - To be eligible to enter into the Breeder/Handler class, you must be one of the breeders of record, or a member of the immediate family of one of the breeders of record. Immediate family includes: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother or sister, so long as the handler is not a professional handler as defined by UKC Rules and Regulations.

7. Licensed Conformation classes consist of:

- A. Regular Classes. Classes for intact dogs:** Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Junior (1 yr., under 2 yrs.); Senior (2yrs., under 3 yrs.); Adult (3 yrs. And up); Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Champion; and Grand Champion.
- B. Altered Classes. Classes for altered dogs.** Altered Puppy (6 mos., under 1 yr.); Altered Junior (1 yr., under 2yrs.); Altered Senior (2yrs., under 3 yrs.); Altered Adult (3 yrs. And up); Altered Brooder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Altered Champion; and Altered Grand Champion.
- C. Junior Showmanship Classes. Corset of:** Fee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 8 yrs.); Novice Junior; Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior; Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)
