Courses & Game:

Chukar, pigeons, pheasant, quail or any combination there-of, will be used in all field test categories. A recognized game bird (duck, chukar, pigeons, or quail) will be used in the FDX water retrieve. Ducks will be used for the WDJ, WD, WDX, and WDE tests. Shooting will be by "Official" gunners only.

FDJ, FD, FDA, FDX, & FDXCH courses will be a single course with a bird field.

FDJ and FD dogs will be run individually.

FDA, FDX, FDXCH dogs will run in braces.

FDJ handlers must carry a starter pistol.

For safety, FD, FDA, FDX, and FDXCH handlers must wear blaze orange clothing items.

Fees:

FDJ - \$65.00 per entry WDJ - \$65.00 per entry FD, FDA, FDX - \$70.00 per entry WD - \$70.00 per entry

WDX, WDE - \$75.00 per entry

No Day of Test entries will be accepted.

Move Ups will be CASH ONLY

Fees are payable in Canadian Funds only.

A listing fee of \$11.30, as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the Entry Form.

All payments must be made prior to the closing date

Entry Close:

Closing of entries will be by Monday, June 3rd 2024 or when the tests are full.

NO females in season will be permitted on the test grounds

Draw:

Running order draw will take place at the home of the Event Test Secretary at 21:00,
 June 8th, 2024.

The drawing will be random and specific times assigned. You will be notified of your start time via email. If two dogs owned by the same person draw consecutive numbers, the second dog will be redrawn.

Prizes:

CKC blue flat ribbon will be awarded to each dog earning a qualifying score.

OVPDC will present rosettes to those that earn a Field or Water Title.

Placement Ribbon's (Places 1st - 4th) will be awarded at the end of each class (i.e. after FDJ)

Shelly Price Field Dog Junior Award: In memory of Shelley Price, long time OVPDC club member and passionate dog sports woman, the third annual 'Shelley Price Field Dog Junior Award' will be awarded on Saturday afternoon to the judges choice, dog & handler team in FDJ class, in recognition of excellent teamwork and sportsmanship.

Meals:

No lunch served for participants. Please bring your own snacks/lunch and water for you and your dog.

Lunch will be provided for judges ONLY

Camping/Hotel:

Limited camping for judges & OVPDC executive ONLY due to space.

Please check for dog friendly accommodations at the Microtel in Casselman, ON if you require them.

Other:

- No training of dogs on the grounds during the test.
- There will be a port-a-potty on test grounds

Special Note: Field Dog Test Rules and Regulations

Paragraph 18.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Dog Test or Water Dog Test is not subject to indignities. The Field/Water Test Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that one has occurred.


Paragraph 11.3

It is mandatory that judges, handlers of the working dogs and marshals, wear a blaze orange outer garment (vest or jacket) and blaze orange headgear in any tests where shotguns are used. The requirements also apply to any gallery members on the course.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee:

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to Canadian Non-Members of the CKC. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards & titles to be canceled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.
