ENTRY INFORMATION

- All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- 3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show/ trials secretary after the closing date and time.
- 6. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 7. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Exhibition Only Altered

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The official CKC classes, divided by sex, will be provided. Enter one category only

Baby Puppy a puppy 3 months up to 6 months on the day of the show
Junior puppy a puppy 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior puppy a puppy between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show
12-18 month puppy a puppy between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of

show

Canadian bred a dog which was born in Canada.

Bred by exhibitor a dog owned and handled by the breeder

Open class all doc

Veterans all dogs 7 years of age or older. Dogs may be neutered.

Altered dogs 6 months & over that have been sexually altered

Specials only dogs who are Canadian champions only Exhibition dogs 3 months and over, not in competition

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number, simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g. AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$50.00 (plus GST or HST where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / Master Card number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months. Senior Class for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months. 12-18 Open for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A ribbon will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class. Rosettes and suitable prizes will be awarded to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be three classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

9-12 years for Dogs at least 9 years of age up to but not including 12 years

Over 12 years for Dogs 12 years of age and older.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A ribbon will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class. Rosettes and suitable prizes will be awarded to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

30% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;

25% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;

20% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.
