What is it ?

The best of both worlds! The practice and stimulation of a real trial environment (in a venue which hosts trials) combined with the coaching of a seminar.

Nested Courses: Pick either the Starters/Advance course numbers or masters/international numbers

Standard: A course that includes all obstacles (contacts, weaves, tire, jumps, table etc).

Jumpers: A numbered course consisting of only jumps, tire and tunnels

Steeplechase: A fun, fast, flowing numbered course that includes jumps, tunnels, a frame and weaves.
