ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You."

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

OWNER HANDLED (OH) DAY! Saturday, September 20th, 2014 Show #4

Rules for Owner Handled Competition
 We are trying to keep the rules as simple as possible.

1. **Owner Handled Box must be checked** on entry form for Sat. Sept 20th - Show #4. (A * will indicate each OH dog listed in both the catalogue and on the Judging sheets.)
2. This is open to all **non-professional** owner-handler. Dogs must be OH throughout the competition.
3. Judging of **OH** will take place after Breed Judging Competition.
4. **OH** Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs eligible to compete for BB.
5. If the BB is **OH** it will automatically be the **OH BB**.
6. If ineligible, then the next highest OH placement will compete against the eligible dogs of the opposite sex.
7. Should none of the BB competitive dogs be **OH** then any **OH** dogs (not directly or indirectly defeated in the classes by an **OH** dog) will be invited back.
8. The **OH BB** dogs will compete for **OH** in Group immediately after Regular Group Judging.
9. Should the Regular Group 1st dog be **OH** then it will be automatically **OH in Group**.
10. If no **OH** places in the Group (1-4) then all **BB OH** dogs will be called into the ring for **OH Group Judging**.
11. If BIS dog is **OH**, then it will automatically be **OH BIS**

RULES

1. Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the C.K.C. and available from the Show Secretary and must include the following information
 - a. Name of Club and date of event.
 - b. Name, address, telephone number, date of birth, signature of Junior Handler.
 - c. Class entered; breed & catalog number of dog to be handled.
2. A Junior Handler may compete with any dog entered in the show, provided he/she had the consent of the owner to do so.
3. The Junior Handler will wear the armband number assigned to the dog for the show.
4. If necessary, due to conflict, substitution of dog will be allowed.
5. Dogs being used in the competition, MUST BE OF APPROPRIATE SIZE AND TEMPERAMENT FOR THE JUNIOR HANDLER. IF PEE-WEE HANDLER CANNOT LIFT DOG, IT IS NOT APPROPRIATE IN SIZE FOR THE COMPETITOR. Dogs being used in competition must also be entered in the show on this date.
6. Classes offered: Pee-Wee, Junior Novice, Junior Open, Intermediate Novice, Intermediate Open, Senior Novice, Senior Open. **Check Poster to determine which age group you are eligible to enter**
7. Complete rules will be published in the Official Show Catalogue
8. A suitable prize and/or Rosette will be offered for Group Placings in each class as well as Best Overall Junior Handler and Participation prizes at each competition.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN.
- Include full payment in the amount of \$56.70 Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- Provide us with your full return address.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.
- An ERN must be obtained within 30 day of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension.
