Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry, will be accepted.

Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured.

Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- 3. Telephone/fax entries are accepted by The Entry Line at 1-800-293-2935; (fax) 519-754-0796. Also, entries may be sent by mail to Specialty Secretary Danuta Booth, address and number found on previous page.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 5. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.
- 6. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for registration can be entered.
- 7. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 8. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE WEDNESDAY 22 JULY 2015.
- 9. Identification cards and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented to the Show Secretary upon arrival at the trial.
- 10. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$30.00 service charge.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Bernese Mountain Dog Club of South-Western Ontario will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- 4. The show precincts shall extend to 10' beyond the outside of the ring

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

First Place winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

A Rosette and prize will be offered for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows:

First in Each Class – 30% of entry fees collected for that class, plus a prize

Second in Each Class – 20% of the entry fees collected for that class

Third in Each Class - 15% of the entry fees collected for that class

Fourth in Each Class – 10% of the entry fees collected for that class

25% will be held for administration costs.

Dogs entered in Juvenile Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class at this show.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The following classes, divided by sex, will be offered at this sweepstakes:

7-9 years -7 years and under 9 years

9-11 years – 9 years and under 11 years

11 + years - 11 years and over

First Place winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes.

A Rosette and prize will be offered for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex Veteran in Sweepstakes.

Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows:

First in Each Class – 30% of entry fees collected for that class plus a prize

Second in Each Class – 20% of the entry fees collected for that class

Third in Each Class - 15% of the entry fees collected for that class

Fourth in Each Class – 10% of the entry fees collected for that class

25% will be held for administration costs.

Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition Only at this show. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Veteran Sweepstakes.

NEW - CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

- 1. A non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. The fee for 2015 is \$59.40 per dog plus applicable taxes.
- 2. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- 3. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and are not applicable to CKC members.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$59.40 per dog after January 1, 2012, plus applicable taxes. CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1. A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from the ring by the judge <u>SHALL NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points.

From the Toronto area or South-Western Ontario: Take Hwy. 403 towards Hamilton. Take exit 61 towards Caledonia/Port Dover/Regional Road 6/Garner Road. Merge onto Hwy 6 via ramp on left towards Caledonia/Port Dover. After 15.5 km, stay straight to go onto Argyle St. N. Turn left onto Caithness St. E. Fairgrounds is on right 0.5 km.

From the Niagara area: Take QEW west to exit 88, Red Hill Parkway. After approx. 9 km, go straight onto Lincoln Alexander Pky W. After approx. 5.5 km, take Upper James St. exit. Keep left at fork in the ramp to Upper James St. After 9.3 km, this becomes Hwy 6. After 6.1 km, stay straight to Argyle St. N. Turn left onto Caithness St. E. Fairgrounds is on the right 0.5 km.
