Entry Fees (Cdn or U.S.): **TD** or **UTD** test: \$80.00; **TDX** or **UTDX** test: \$95.00

A Listing Fee of \$11.30 Cdn or U.S. must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number, or Event Registration Number (ERN), is not shown on the entry form. The registration number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entry in a CKC event.

- U.S. Exhibitors: We accept U.S. cheques or U.S. bank Money orders in U.S. funds. Please do not mark U.S. cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" as the bank will not accept them.
- An NSF cheque will be subject to a \$40.00 service charge. The Entry fee plus NSF service charge must be paid in cash prior to competing.
- Faxed, emailed, drop-box or hand-delivered entries will NOT be accepted.

Field & Urban Tracking Tests: October 27-28, 2018: General Information

- ** SATURDAY:. Field day only, TD & TDX (4 of each, exchanges possible*)
- ** SUNDAY: UTD (max 2), UTDX (max 4, depending on site availability*) and possible TD (exchanges).

 *See entry form. Any exchanges will depend on club/site resources, and as per CKC tracking rules 6.2.2.

ELIGIBILITY:

- A CKC TD title is a prerequisite for entering either a CKC UTD test or TDX test.
- A dog eligible for a PEN number must have their PEN number prior to entering the test, and may not enter as a Listed dog.
- A Listing Fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.
- Canadian entrants who are not CKC Members: An annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles
 will be charged for dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member. This fee is not applicable to CKC members or
 dogs co-owned by CKC members. Non-CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or
 pay the Non-Member Participation Fee within 30 days of notification, or awards will be cancelled by the CKC.

ENTRIES, DRAW, ALTERNATE LIST, and REFUNDS:

- Entrants will be notified by email or phone when their entry has been received by the Test Secretary.
- A draw of all entries received by the closing date will take place at the Canine Coaching Club on Wednesday, October 10th, 7:30pm for placement into each test & alternate list. Exhibitors will be notified within 24 hours of draw completion.
- Club Worker Draw (per CKC 6.6.2): At the entry draws, 1 TD & 1 TDX (Sat) and 1 UTDX (Sun) may be reserved for eligible "Club Workers" as defined by the TBK&TC Tracking committee. The worker draw precedes the regular draw, and any worker entries not drawn are then returned into the Regular draw.
- An entry of a non-titled dog in a given class (level) will be given preference over the entry of a dog already
 having the CKC title in that class/level. (CKC rule 6.1.18). Purebred dogs untitled or titled have preference
 over entries of Mixed Breed or Unrecognized breeds.
- If an entered dog is withdrawn after the closing date, a refund will be given if the vacancy is accepted by an Alternate. Alternates will be contacted in Catalogue order and may accept or decline. Remaining Alternates as of test day are encouraged to attend the draw in case there is a withdrawal or no-show of a confirmed entrant.
- Cheques for entries not drawn will not be cashed and will be returned or destroyed at exhibitor's option
- Bitches in season will be permitted to compete, but may be assigned the last track at the judge's discretion. Please advise the Test Secretary immediately upon arrival at the meeting place, **or earlier if possible**.
- <u>DISCIPLINE: RULE 14.7</u> The test-giving club has the duty and obligation to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Club shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation
