The precincts of these events will be the areas used exclusively by the show giving club. Persons not adhering to this rule will be ejected from the show and the venue without refunding of fees.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE:

Every dog entered in an approved event or sanctioned match must be one of the following:

1. a) Registered with the CKC
2. b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
3. c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN)
4. d) Eligible for registration with the CKC, and have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)
5. e) Registered as a Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever

To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be a Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever that is 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, CCN, Eligible for registration with the CKC.

A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked. Dogs must not be lame or must not compete if tape or bandages may impair its working ability. Dogs with physical challenges are eligible to compete, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search.

ENTRY LIMIT: These Trials are limited. If the tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

Handlers may only handle 1 dog in each component at each level. NO RESETS WILL BE OFFERED Dogs can only be entered in Open, Excellent or Master components if they have already qualified at the preceding level in that component.

MOVE UPS: Same day trial move-ups will not be allowed.

JUDGING SCHEDULES: sent by email to exhibitors after the closing date

EQUIPMENT: The dog may wear a buckle, snap or martingale collar and/or body harness in the ring. Collars/harnesses with tags may be worn in the ring. Harnesses may have the leash attached to the front clip or on the back. Electronic training and pinch collars are not allowed on the grounds.

PENALTIES ISSUED BY THE CLUB: Dropping food while rewarding is considered contamination. Contamination of the search area, at the discretion of the Judge may result in a non-qualifying score. Any dog that urinates or defecates or vomits within the search area will be excused from the class and will result in a non-qualifying score.

SCENT DETECTION RULEBOOK: It is up to the individual handler to review the CKC Scent Detection Rulebook prior to the trial. New rulebook Jan 1, 2024. REMINDER: That anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season are permitted to compete at this event. They must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties. Please notify show secretary prior to the event.

TEST SITE: No indoor kennelling. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test (where off leash searches are permitted). NO non-trial odour is permitted on the trial grounds. No warm up area will be offered.

Remember that this is a private commercial facility. Clean up after yourself and your dog, failure to do so will be immediate expulsion from the event.

We welcome all exhibitors, including persons with disabilities. The trial facility is not wheelchair accessible. Stairs are needed to access the building and may be used during the trial to access some search areas. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the show secretary by entry closing to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

Washroom facilities are on site.

ADDITIONAL TRIAL AND VENUE INFORMATION:

1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the trial. The Event Chairperson shall have full control of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the chairperson or veterinarian for any reason, shall not, after being excused compete in any class for any award for the balance of the trial.
3. The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability for, either dogs, exhibitors or patrons in the event of an accident or misfortune.
4. The owner of a dog entered in these trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
5. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, there is no refund of entry.
6. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
7. Please allow for absentees and variances in the rate of judging.
8. Please Obey ENTER and EXIT gates in the trial area.
9. Dogs and equipment shall not be left unattended at the trial venue.
10. Dogs must be on leash at all times inside the trial venue and trial grounds.
11. Exhibitors will be required to crate their dogs in their vehicle. Please be prepared for all types of weather.
12. Spectators are permitted but only in designated areas. Food other than that used as a distraction for the search will not be allowed. As per CKC Rules Spectators are encouraged to photo and video dogs and handlers while they search, however under no circumstances may they share this with any handler competing in the same class who has not yet run. Handlers are not allowed to take video while handling a dog. These videos are for the enjoyment of those who cannot be present to watch the team search, and for the handler to have a keepsake of their experience.
13. Access to parking will be allowed starting at 8:00 am. Please follow posted signage. Please Park neatly. Please adhere to Fire Lanes in all areas around the venue. Street Parking is reserved for Judges and Volunteers. All exhibitors need to use the lower parking lot located behind the building. Entrance is located at the end of the building.
14. Excellent and Master levels will be held in the upper hall. Teams will need to climb stairs or walk up the driveway.
15. Exhibitors are expected to maintain a clean area. Please be considerate when utilizing the facilities. No dogs are permitted in the washrooms.
16. Bring your own food and drinks, for yourself and your dog.
17. No overnight recreational parking will be provided.
18. Exhibitors and Participants are expected to follow these event guidelines. Failure to comply may result in excusal from the remainder of this event. The club reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the show and the venue, which are governed by CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB (CKC) rules.

PENALTIES ISSUED BY CLUB: Dropping food while rewarding is considered a contamination. Contamination of the search area will result in a non-qualifying score and any dog that urinates, defecates or vomits within the search area will be excused from the competition. Destruction of trial property (excessive scratching or subsequent breaking of an item) may have a monetary penalty of \$10.00 enforced.

I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold NSDT Retriever Club of Canada, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
