Location: The Club is grateful to have the use of these grounds owned by Wessex Game Birds. A map showing the location of the grounds will be provided to entrants at the time the running order is distributed. We ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas and limited if grounds are wet.

General Information:

- **Courses and Birds** – Partridge, Quail and/or pheasant will be released. The tests will be over a single course with birds released along the course. There will not be a bird field. Three birds will be released for the first dog tested and two birds per dog thereafter. In FDX 5 birds will be released for the first brace and two birds per dog thereafter. The BSCC reserves the right in case of bird shortage, to use alternate bird species.
- **Horses on the course** – Bird planters and marshals may use horses. All other participants and spectators must be on foot. **All dogs will be handled on foot.**
- **Clothing** - All persons on the course in FD, FDA and FDX must wear a blaze orange garment, a hat alone will not be allowed. If you do not have one, items will be provided.
- **Gallery** - a gallery of spectators may be permitted. This will be at the discretion of the judges and handlers. Spectators in FD, FDA and FDX must remain together at all times and shall follow the directions of the judges, marshal and gunners. All other spectators must remain in the camp area.
- **Entries** - Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in approximately eight (8) hours of judging time.
- **Starting times** - will be announced (earliest start will be 7 a.m.) running times are an estimate only and may change due to absentees or dogs "picked up" early. It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn to run.

- **Firearms** – Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD, FDA and FDX shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by **official gunners only**. In FDJ blank shells will be fired – please provide your own starting pistol.
- **In Season Bitches** - Bitches in season **will not** be permitted to run.
- **Collaring** – collaring of a dog is allowed with the permission of the judge
- **Tracking Collars**: The BSCC is allowing the use of electronic tracking collars in this test. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed. Participants must declare that they are using the tracking collars to the Field Test chairman and also to the judges. Only Garmin GPS collars that are approved for use in Canada and will be permitted. **NOTE**: as per rule 11.4.10 With the exception of tracking collars, collars to be worn in competitive stakes must be a type solely used for purposes of identification. That is, the normal dog collar with name plate attached **or** coloured collars used to distinguish between dogs in a brace. 11.6.6 states that no more than two collars may be worn by a dog.
- **Training or exercising** – training or exercising of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds during the test weekend (from Friday evening until completion of judging on Sunday).
- **Smoking** – is prohibited except in your parked vehicles. **NO OPEN FIRES WILL BE ALLOWED.**
- **Food** - There will be no hospitality available.

HOTEL/MOTELS - Carstairs - 20 min east - Golden West Motor Inn (pet friendly); **Three Hills** 35 min northeast - Best Western (pet friendly), Super 8 (pet friendly), Lamplighter Inn (pet friendly). ; **Drumheller** - 50 min west - a number of hotels; **Olds** - 45 min northwest - a number of hotels; **Didsbury** and **Crossfield** hotels - not pet friendly
- **Prizes** – Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. **We will attempt to provide scores and ribbons as quickly as possible after each run, allowing participants to depart the grounds after running their dog.**
- **Rules** – All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of the Premium List. Entries: Entries will **open** at 6 p.m. Tuesday May 30, 2023, and **close** at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday June 6, 2023. Draw will follow after closing at the home of the Field Test Secretary. Online entries through our event partner www.dogshow.ca are preferred, for those who choose not to enter online, the entry must be sent to the Field Test Secretary who may be contacted at cathiewhitehead@shaw.ca for further instructions. Payment in full must accompany all entries.

IMPORTANT CHANGE: TCN Number: (Previously Listing fees) A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) as established by The Canadian Kennel Club and **MUST ACCOMPANY** the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This fee is \$10.50 (including GST) per dog per each event entered during the field test and is in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records. Please visit www.CKC.ca to obtain your TCN

All entries for this Field Test are accepted on condition that the BSCC, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this Field Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.
