#### **CONFORMATION**

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

#### **Regular Classes:**

**JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS** – for dogs 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show.

**SENIOR PUPPY CLASS** – for dogs 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show.

**12 to 18 MONTH CLASS** – for dogs 12 months & under 18 months on the day of the show.

**CANADIAN BRED CLASS** – for dogs born in Canada; Champions in any other country excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR -** shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder **OPEN CLASS** – for all dogs.

**SPECIALS ONLY** – This class will not be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible, it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

#### **UNOFFICAL CLASSES**

**EXHIBITION ONLY** – Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

#### **CKC Show Rules & Regulations**

- 4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.
- 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

#### **Temporary Competition Numbers**

All dogs entered in CKC events that are not CKC registered must have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) before entering into the event(s). This includes Baby Puppies in Conformation shows. Please note that Listed Breeds are not eligible for a TCN (effective July 6, 2021, this includes Baby Puppies). Listed Breeds must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) before entering into an event. The Conformation Show Rules will be updated in this regard.

#### **Non-member participation fee**

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

#### EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

#### **ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3**

Entry forms received by the CKC that are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

#### **ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5**

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

#### **ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1**

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. have an Event Registration Number
- c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous

Certification Number (MCN)

#### **REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2**

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

#### **DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4**

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. 

#### **Trophies**

Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> in each class (except Pee Wee Class, who will receive participant flatribbons) and for Best Overall Handler.

#### **Junior Handling Number**

Effective January 2016, Junior Handlers, with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handler Number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked. Dogs and equipment may be left in the building at owner's/agent's own risk.





#### **CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 +
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

<sup>\*</sup>Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

- 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.
- 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.
- 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
- 15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:
  (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As of July 2021, The Rules For Awarding Of Grand Champion And Grand Champion Excellent Have Changed. Please See The CKC Conformation Rule Book 15.2 Grand Champion (Gch) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (Gchex) Rules

#### **GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS**

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation rule book are available from the CKC, #400 – 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9.

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to anyindignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receiptof a report indicating that this rule has been violated. There will be a ZERO tolerance for this kind of behavior, and should this occur, the offender may be excused from the show/building by the Show Superintendent or his/her representative.
- 5. Unsportsmanlike conduct (e.g. loud, abusive, profanity ringside, etc.) will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the show. Please demonstrate sportsmanlike behavior while on the show grounds as a good example to other exhibitors and to spectators
- 6. Exhibitors are required to clean up their benching area upon leaving. Those who do not will be billed a \$50.00 clean-up fee which must be paid before entering future PAKOC events Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any servicefor notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC STANDARD TIME.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless ofhow or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. Dogs will be allowed to stay in the building overnight; however, they will be left at the owner's/handler's own risk. There will be security on site. Please leave name and contact information in plain view at your benching site so that you may be contacted in necessary
- 9. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at ashow under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatementmust be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 10.Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the show grounds.
- 11. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators, we insist upon keeping the grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it into the judging ring. **Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only**, not in the vicinityof the ring areas.

- 12. As per CKC rules all dogs on the show premises MUST be listed in the show catalogue. Any dogs not listed will be asked to leave. If you have a dog at the show that is not entered, Please obtain an "IN TRANSIT" ticket from the Show Secretary (no charge). Because we have limited benching space, please leave your extra dogs at home
- 13. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, anact of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 14. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is entered incorrectly, absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 16.Entries will be acknowledged after entry by DogShow.ca and a judging schedule will be available after the closing date. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the

#### **Show Secretary**

The show grounds/building will be opened Thursday at 2:00 PM (NO SOONER) to 11:00PM for exhibitors to set up. \*\*The Club volunteers ask that you please wait until 2 pm before coming into the building so that they all have the time to complete what they need to do. The building will be open from 6:30 AM to 11:00P M Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

- 17. For those of you "Ringing in the New Year" The building will be open from 6:30AM until 12:00pm on Sunday Jan 1. Please ensure you have vacated your set up by this time.
- 18. The bottoms of all ex-pens and wire crate bottoms must be lined with plastic supplied by the owner or handler.

Smoking Bylaws: This is a NO SMOKING venue. Electronic smoking devices and other oral smoking devices are included in this bylaw.

#### **SHOW TIMES**

All start times will be specified in the judging schedule emailed to all exhibitors after entries close. Both shows each day will be judged concurrently. Group judging will commence immediately following the breed judging. No two groups will be judged at the same time. Should a conflict arise between groups, the Chief Ring Steward shall rule as to what order the Groups show. Best In Show will follow shortly after the last group has been judged.

#### **RESERVED BENCHING**
