

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided.

#### Regular Classes:

for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age Junior Puppy.... Senior Puppy.... for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age 12-18 Months....

Canadian Bred.... for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded

Bred by Exhibitor.. for dogs owned and handles in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further

awards

Open..... for all dogs

for any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the Veteran.....

winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. Dogs competing in this class may be spayed or

neutered.

Specials Only... for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at

time of closing. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is not allowed.

Exhibition Only... dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-regular

classes

Exhibition Only (3-6 mon)... Puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 months provided the owner has entered a dog in a regular official class. These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-

regular or unofficial class.

#### Sexually Altered Classes:

Judging will be after Best of Breed in the Regular Classes. For any sexually altered Salukis over 6 months of age, eligible for registration with the CKC. Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes. The first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed and Best Opposite Sex Altered.

Non-Regular Classes:

Juvenile Sweepstakes -Classes will be divided by age only as follows:

> 6-9 months 9-12 months 12-18 months

The winner in each class will compete for Best in Juvenile Sweepstakes.

To compete in Juvenile Sweepstakes, dogs must be entered in a Regular class or for Specials Only. Entry in Juvenile Sweepstakes from the Exhibition Only class is not allowed.

To compete in the following Non-regular cases, all dogs must be entered in the regular classes, veterans class, Specials Only or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Veterans Sweepstakes -Classes will be divided by age only as follows:

7-9 years 10 years and older

The winners of each class will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepskates

Two dogs (either sex or mixed) not necessarily owned by the same owner, shown on one lead by one handler, Stud Dog & Get... Stud Dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brood Bitch & Progeny... Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.
