All Junior Handlers must handle a Dachshund but need not own it.

Classes Offered: Pee Wee / Junior Novice / Intermediate Novice / Senior Novice / Junior Open / Intermediate Open / Senior Open.

Age Structure: Pee Wee (4-6 years), Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

Held under CKC Rules. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show/trial on that day. The CKOC will be offering a rosette for the Best Overall Junior Handler **Please Note: Effective Jan. 1, 2016 - **Section 3.4.1 "All Junior Handlers with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."**

A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

U.S. Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not **mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.** Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

FEES / CHEQUES / N.S.F. CHEQUES:

All fees must accompany your entries. No entries will be accepted without accompanying full payment. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$50.00 fee charged for any N.S.F. funds issued to the Prince Albert Kennel & Obedience Club. (Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted). Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded.

OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMS

ENTRIES MUST BE TYPED OR DISTINCTLY PRINTED. Owners are responsible for errors on entries. Incomplete entry forms must be returned to the designated owner or his authorized agent. Unsigned, telephone, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal strike when telephone entries may be made in accordance with the Canadian Kennel Club Regulations.

CLASSES

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All of these classes must be divided by sex. Note: no dogs under the age of six months on the first day of the show shall be allowed within the Show precincts as defined in the Premium List. Every dog within these must be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes or in Exhibition Only.

JUNIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs nine months of age and under twelve months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MONTH: for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any other country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder /co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: for all dogs.

VETERANS: for dogs 7 years of age and over. Can be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

NON REGULAR CLASSES:

- EXHIBITION ONLY (4-6 Months): Puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. Puppies in this category may enter and compete in Sweepstakes if a 4-6 months class is offered.
- EXHIBITION ONLY: Must be entered in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions; may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if offered.
- BABY PUPPY: 4 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Winners of this class do not compete for points. The class is to be judged after breed judging.

CKC Show Rules & Regulations

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.\

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	2	3 – 5	6 – 9	10 – 12	13 or more
Points	1	2	3	4	5
* includes the dog awarded Winners					

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

REMINDER TO ALL EXHIBITORS: No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable event.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

RE: COVID-19 MANDATES:

Should the COVID-19 situation require it, PDC will follow any mandates required by SHA at the time of the shows/trials. If necessary, applicable information will be provided to all exhibitors via email messages.
