The Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS: Personal cheques will be accepted however, **they must be payable for the FULL AMOUNT OF THE ENTRY, payable in US funds. Discounted cheques will not be honoured. Do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds or "at par".**

Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination

PLEASE NOTE: Dogs should be crated when left unattended in rooms. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs on hotel/motel grounds. Please cooperate as we want hotels/motels to continue to welcome our Exhibitors and their dogs again.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER FOR FOREIGN DOGS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN - Event Registration Number**. For information on obtaining an ERN, visit the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca> At the latest, the ERN must be applied for within 30 days of first day of entering a CKC event.

***Non Member Participation Fee** (section 24-12-3) (April 2011), will be charged to a resident of Canada, who is a non-member of the C.K.C. The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order of the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to: either become a C.K.C. member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. All premium lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to C.K.C. members. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

GENERAL INFORMATION

➤ Meet at 8:00 am, dogs to line at 8:30 am. Check in with the marshal on arrival.

➤ Running order will be determined by a draw; if possible handlers with more than one dog will run in non-consecutive order. Include name of handler on entry form. A running list will be available at the tests.

➤ A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC (or has an ERN or PEN), and has completed the requirements for a WC or WCI may be transferred to the next level provided the request is submitted to the test secretary in writing by 6 pm the day prior to the test.

➤ Pheasants, ducks, chukars or any other regional game birds may be used on land for the hunt tests. Pheasants, ducks or pigeons may be used on land for the working certificate tests.

➤ Ducks will be used in water for both the hunt and working certificate tests.

➤ No confirmation of receipt of entry will be sent.

➤ All qualifying dogs will be awarded a rosette or ribbon.

➤ Separate entry forms should be completed for each dog and each test entered.

➤ All handlers in the hunt test must wear dark or camouflage clothing. No white or light clothing is allowed in the working certificate test.

➤ All dogs must be kept under control at all times.

➤ Bitches in season may NOT be entered in the WC tests or the Hunt tests.

➤ Lunches MUST be pre-ordered at a cost of \$8 per lunch.

➤ Tailgate dinner on Saturday night at a cost of \$8 per person. Bring your own meat to BBQ, all else will be provided.

TEST HEADQUARTERS

RR #1, 581 Nicholettes Road, Murillo. From the 11/17 expressway, take the Oliver Road exit west from Thunder Bay. Turn right on Nicholettes Road. At the stop sign, cross John Street Road. Headquarters is on the left a short distance up the road. Contact the test secretary if additional information is required.
