Show precincts shall consist of Sudbury& District Kennel Club Training Hall & Grounds. Ring is 100' by 100' grass surface Dogs must be on leash at all times when outside the ring.

Obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice Standard classes immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Dogs may only participate in the familiarization on the first day of the weekend that they are entered.

Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2010.

MOVING UP: Dogs may move up on the day of the trial one hour prior to the commencement of each trial. No electronic timers.

Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment and such entries will be returned. *** A service charge of \$30.00 CDN will be applied to all returned cheques***

General Information: The Trial Secretary and Superintendent are in full charge of the Trials.

Food and toys are not permitted in the ring and no one is permitted to bench or use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the ring. Dogs must be ON LEASH at all times except in the ring. PLEASE STOOP TO SCOOP!

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do no mark cheques "Payable in Canadian funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. **Thank you. Eligibility**: To be eligible to compete in an agility trial, the dog must be 18 months of age and registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, or have a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. The judge of an agility trial must remove from competition any bitch in season, or any bitch which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element. When a bitch

comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial Secretary and a Veterinarian's certificate that the bitch was in season within

the ten day period preceding the trial, the Trial giving club will refund entry, service charges and listing fees.

Exhibitor information: Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations Effective January 2010. A copy of which may be obtained by calling the Central Order Desk of CKC at 1-800-250-8040

Agility Rules & Regulations

4.1.3: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Non-Member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards titles earned, the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members

The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Cost is \$55.00 + HST

<u>For Exhibition Only runs (FEO runs)</u>

Under the CKC's new "show modeling" program we have been granted permission to offer FEO runs at these trials. No CKC number is needed to participate in FEO runs. CKC will not be tracking these scores nor will they count towards a CKC title, however SDKC will be awarding ribbons to qualifying scores. Exhibitors may enter FEO runs as many times as they like at a trial, at any level they like, provided that they offer evidence that the dog will have success at that level (The dog runs Masters at AAC and a person would like to run Excellent in CKC). It is recommended that the dog starts at the Novice level in the trial and progress. FEO entries MUST be received by the secretary no later than 15 minutes prior to the class you want to run in. SDKC reserves the right to refuse an FEO entry and also to decide when FEO entries will run. An FEO run will be accepted ONLY if there is room in that trial. FEO runs will run at the end of the jump heights within the correct class.

Mixed Breed Dogs

Under the CKC's show modeling program, we have been granted permission to allow dogs of mixed breed origin to participant in FEO runs. All FEO rules apply to this section as well.
