RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
2. A DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1-HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM ENTRY IS MADE
6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
7. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS
8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.

ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below;

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

JUDGES' ASSIGNMENTS

All Regular classes

Show precincts shall be within 30 feet of the designated Specialty ring.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following regular CKC classes will be offered for both sexes:

JUNIOR PUPPY	6 months and under 9 months
SENIOR PUPPY	9 months and under 12 months
12 – 18 MONTHS	12 months and under 18 months
CANADIAN BRED	For dogs born in Canada, champions in any country excluded
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	For dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.
OPEN	For all dogs.
VETERANS	For dogs 7 years of age or over as of the date of the show. These dogs will compete for regular placement and the first place dog will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans class will NOT compete for the points, but will go directly into Best of Breed competition.
SPECIALS ONLY	For dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for championship status.
EXHIBITION ONLY	All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class, but may enter and compete in non-regular classes and/or parades.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition
3 - 6 MONTHS	Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or parades</u>

Withdrawal of Entries

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Specialty Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show and it will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Tyee Kennel Club premium list, will apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7.

Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques & declined credit cards will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules). Entries may be paid by Visa/MasterCard/Amex/Discover. Greyhound entries must be prepaid for delivery and will not be picked up. Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. **Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.**

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you use our on-line entry and pay by credit cards or purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. 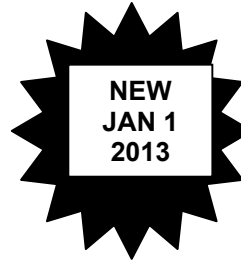

GRAND CHAMPION

(synopsis only – full details posted on CKC website
Points towards a Grand Championship cannot be gained until a dog completes its Canadian Championship. The accumulation of points began January 1, 2013. The dog must compete in the Specials Only class. Twenty points are needed for the title (the forms are available for download from the CKC website and it is the responsibility of the owner to keep track and when they reach the 20 points, submit the form to CKC who will verify the wins, and if correct will issue a certificate). In the 20 points there needs to be a minimum of 1 Best of Breed and at least 2 – 2 point wins. The scale of points is the same as for regular championships. A judge will select Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch (the latter 2 will be chosen from the remaining Specials dogs competing, if any in competition). The points are based on the total number of dogs defeated



EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.”
