- BITCHES IN SEASON: Obedience entry fees WILL be gladly refunded to exhibitors whose females are in season during the trials (and must be withdrawn) IF: a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the trial.
- THE PRECINCTS of these trials shall be the Manhattan building & grounds. No dog will be allowed in the building unless entered in the Trials or Exhibition Only.
