The BC All Breed Pointer Club will conduct 2 licensed field tests for all pointing breeds at Hedges Butte Ranch, 1150 Marron Valley Road, Penticton, B.C. This trial is held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400, 200 Ronson Drive, Etobicoke ON M9W 5Z9

NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAME OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE OF YOUR VEHICLE. THIS AREA IS EXTREMELY DRY AND SENSITIVE TO THE SMALLEST SPARK.

COURSES & BIRDS

All tests are single course with bird field. All dogs with bird work will be shot over with blank cartridges on game contact. Either of quail, chucker, pheasant or pigeons will be used in all tests. Any dog encountering native game birds on the course must point and be shot over. Dogs will be run individually for FDJ and FD tests and braced for FDX. All tests are walking tests (foot-handled) only.

HANDLING

All dogs must be handled by a handler on foot. The duty of having a dog ready in place when required for judging rests solely with its handler or owner. If a dog is not present at the place where it is to start within 5 minutes after it is called for by the judges to run, it must be disqualified. The judges are responsible for keeping the time. In a test on a single course with a bird field the time in the bird field shall be **no less than 8 minutes**. No dog shall be picked up during a test except with permission from the judge. There shall be no training of dogs anywhere on the course during the test.

PLEASE NOTE

- The BCABPC reserves the right to limit entries to the available daylight hours and if necessary to rearrange the running order.
- Bitches in season may run at the end of test 2.
- Collaring is permitted.
- Dogs may <u>not</u> be run on the grounds prior to Test start.. Running of dogs on the grounds following the completion of the final Test is at the discretion of the Test Chairman.
- Entries may be accepted on the day of the test, with an additional fee of \$20 per test.

ADDITIONAL DIRECTIVES

The BCABPC is a member of the CKC and the Northwest Field Trial Council.

CKC, **Chapter 16**: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Field Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Liability: All entries are accepted on the condition that the BC All Breed Pointer Club, its officers, directors, membership and landowners assume no responsibility for participants or spectators in the event of injury or damage to; persons, animals or properties in conjunction with or during the running of these field tests.

Listing Fee: A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC Individual Registration Number, Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number MCN) is not shown on the entry form.

ENTRY FEES

Are to be paid in Canadian funds by cash, cheque or money order payable to the BC All Breed Pointer Club. The Field Test Secretary will acknowledge the receipt of electronically transmitted entries. All entry forms are to be completed and in the hands of the Field Test Secretary and entry fees paid in full prior to the running of a dog.

PAYMENT - INCLUDING US OR FOREIGN PARTICIPANTS

All fees are payable in Canadian funds: US participants please purchase bank drafts or money orders in Canadian funds. Your co-operation is appreciated, thank you. The tendering of NSF cheques or cheques postdated beyond the closing date shall be considered as non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque.

Canadian-Resident Entrants That Are Not CKC Members

Effective January 1, 2011, the Canadian Kennel Club has implemented an annual non-CKC-member participation fee. Canadian-resident owners who are not members of the CKC must pay this annual participation fee or join the CKC. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of awards and titles. For co-owned dogs, one of the owners must supply a CKC membership number or pay the fee/join CKC. The above applies only to Canadian residents; American-owned dogs are exempt. The test secretary will have some of the forms available at the test; it is the entrants' responsibility to submit the form and fee to CKC.

BORDER CROSSING

A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and the USA. Government regulations require a valid Rabies Certificate dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Please note that border crossings now involve more thorough inspection of vehicles, dogs and papers. Proof of citizenship is required for entry into Canada and return to the USA. Please carry a Passport, naturalization papers etc as proof of citizenship. You can borrow a starter pistol if you decide not to bring one across the border.

DIRECTIONS:

Location of Event: Hedges Butte Ranch, 1150 Marron Valley Rd, Penticton, BC 250-490-0750

From Penticton:

Take Green Mountain Rd approximately 13km from Hwy 97. Turn left onto Marron Valley Rd. Go exactly 4kms to test grounds on your right.

From Keremeos:

Take Hwy 3A toward Penticton. Approximately 2km past the Twin Lakes Golf Course and Spot Gas Station turn left onto Marron Valley Rd. Go exactly 6.5km to the test grounds on your left.

Reminder: The BCABPC wishes to remind all participants and spectators that there will be no exercising or training of any dogs on the grounds before, during, or after the Trial. All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules & provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial rulebooks are available from the CKC or on-line at the CKC website for CKC members.

Prizes: Standard CKC rosettes and prizes will be awarded to the placing dogs in all stakes.

Entries: Entries should be submitted to Field Trial Secretary at the address listed ABOVE before closing.
