Entries will be accepted until the draw date. Dogs not registered in Canada must obtain a TCN before submitting an entry for a field trial. TCN's can be obtained from the CKC online, by paper application, or by contacting the Shows & Trials division toll free at 1-855-364-7252. A TCN fee of \$10.50 must be included with your entry for the trial. CKC registration or ERN/PEN number must be applied for within 30 days of the trial date or all wins and awards will be cancelled.

**Please note the new CKC ruling:** Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Starting dogs in the major stakes will be determined by the TSX closing on **Thursday, May 5th, 2022** and will be based on the running order posted prior to commencement of the trial. A system of rotation will be used for the start of subsequent series in the all-age stakes.  
**A system of rotation may be used in the minor stakes.**

- Ducks or pheasants will be used at all stakes
- Wingers may be used
- Stakes may run into the next day
- Males & females will be run in the order of the draw or at the discretion of the Marshall
- Bitches in season may not compete and must be withdrawn

- Entry listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the FT Secretary before the start of the stake to qualify for a refund
- Prizes and /or rosettes will be awarded for each placing and will be presented at the conclusion of each stake

**Retriever Field Trial Rules & Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club State In:**

**Section 21.7, Page 68**

“It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.”

**Section 3.3.2, Page 7**

"Judges shall have the authority to disqualify any dog which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tried."

**Release and Indemnification**

By participating in these trials (as handler, spectator or in any other role) each participant agrees to assume all risk and hazards incidental to these trials and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the British Columbia Labrador Retriever Club Society and its members, any volunteer and the owners of the property upon which the tests are held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, cost expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property.
