As per the CKC rules, it shall be the duty and obligation of the test giving club to see that a judge, club official, or any participant at an event held under the CKC rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind.

The Nova Scotia German Shepherd Dog Club will use all reasonable care to guarantee the safety of dogs and persons at the test; however, neither the NSGSDC nor any individual will accept the responsibility for loss or injury however caused to any dog, person, or property.

ENTRY FEES (including HST):

TD Test..... \$80.00
TDX Test..... \$90.00

LISTING FEES: A Listing Fee of \$11.50 must accompany the entry form of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER: \$10.00 “A TCN fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.”

Ch. 6.1.19 “Entries must be delivered to the event secretary as stated on the premium list. At its option in addition to mail, the club may elect to receive entries by hand, by courier or by email. If the club chooses to accept email entries, it may also choose to accept e-transfer for the entry fees. The entry of a dog at a test held under these rules must be accompanied by the entry fee.”

Mail entries and fees to the Test Secretary, or email entries and e-transfers to paul@bandpetsupplies.ca. All cheques or money orders should be made payable to the Nova Scotia German Shepherd Dog Club (or NSGSDC). No post-dated cheques will be accepted.

As per Sec 6.6.2, one test track will be set aside for Club workers on Sunday.

CLOSING DATE: Entries must be received by the Test Secretary by the closing date. The Club cannot accept entries received after this date and time. After the closing date, the Club will send out acceptance letters, advising entrants of the status of their entries.

LIMIT OF ENTRIES – Sunday, October 20th
3 Tracking Dog Tests (TD)
2 Tracking Dog Excellent Tests (TDX)

All entries received prior to the closing date will be acknowledged by mail/email and entered in entry draw. Entries not drawn shall be assigned a position on an “Alternate List” in the order received. Entries from the Alternate List may fill any absentee spaces up until one hour before the start of the Tracking Test. The person making the entry shall be notified of their position on the alternate list. Entries will be refunded within ten (10) days of the Tracking Test to those on the Alternate List who did not participate in the Test.

14.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE - Effective January 1, 2011, the Canadian Kennel Club has implemented a non-member participation fee which will be charged to a resident of Canada who is not a member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by the non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
