In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$45.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Customers whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$45.00 for each transaction declined. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$59.40.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. CKC REGULAR CLASSES (divided by sex)

Baby Puppy: puppies 3-6 months of age. These puppies do not compete for championship points.

Baby Puppies may enter and compete in Sweepstakes.

Junior Puppy: 6 months of age & under 9 months

Senior Puppy: 9 months of age & under 12 months

12- 18 month: 12 months of age & under 18 months

Canadian Bred: dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred by Exhibitor: owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner, co-owner and breeder, co-breeder of the dog.

Open: for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC

Veterans: for any dog 7 years or older on the day of the show. *Note: Veterans dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed.* **DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.**

Specials Only: dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have an ERN (Event Registration Number) and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" Class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the C.K.C., but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a "Listed Dog" in this class is NOT allowed.

NON-REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES:

Altered: Altered will be divided Males and Females with a Best of Breed and Best of Opposite awarded. All dogs must be surgically altered to enter this class.

The following additional Non-Regular classes will be offered. Any dog entered in these classes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only

Stud Dog & Get: Stud Dog and two or more (up to four) of his get. Sire and get need not be owned by the same person. Stud Dog must be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Brood bitch and two or more (up to four) of her progeny. Dam and progeny need not be owned by the same person. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class.

Brace: For two dogs, not necessarily of the same sex, handled on the same lead.

SWEEPSTAKES

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

To Compete In Any Sweepstakes Class, Dogs Must Be Entered In A Regular Class Or For Specials Only.

Entry In Juvenile Sweepstakes From The Exhibition Only Class Is Not Allowed **Except For Puppies Aged 3-6 Months. 3-6 Month Old Puppies May Enter From The Exhibition Only (3-6 Mos.) Class Or From The Baby Puppy Class.**

Classes Will Be Divided By Age As Follows:

3-6 months 6-9 months 9-12 months 12-18 months

The winners of all four classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. The TFTCC will retain 25% of collected entry fees for expenses. The remaining fees will be distributed as follows:

1st in each class – 25% of entry fees for that class & a rosette
2nd in each class – 10% of entry fees for that class & a rosette
3rd in each class – 5% of entry fees for that class & a rosette
Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded a rosette and 35% of total entry fees

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Classes will be divided by Sex:

Veterans Male/Female – 7-10 years /Veterans Male/Female – 10 years and over

The winners of all four classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. The TFTCC will retain 25% of collected entry fees for expenses. The remaining fees will be distributed as follows:

1st in each class – 25% of entry fees for that class
2nd in each class – 10% of entry fees for that class
3rd in each class – 5% of entry fees for that class
Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded a rosette and 35% of total entry fees

BREEDER SWEEPSTAKES

Open to any Toy Fox Terrier entered in the Regular classes at this Specialty.

Entry In Breeder Sweepstakes From The Exhibition Only Class Is Not Allowed.

Each dog must be handled by its breeder but does not have to be owned by its breeder. The TFTCC will retain 25% of collected entry fees for expenses. The remaining fees will be distributed as follows:

Best in Breeder Sweeps will be awarded a rosette and 75% of total entry fees.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided here under. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group. A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Best in Show (5 points)(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship. A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Grand Champion Excellent point system

Win	Points
First in Group or Best in Specialty Show	5
Second in Group of Best of Opposite Single-Breed Specialty Show	4
Third in Group	3
Fourth in Group (Note: No points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group.)	2
Best of Breed (To earn the breed point, at least five (5) dogs must be shown at breed level.)	1
Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show	10

Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. For example, a dog that wins first in group and then wins Best in Show, earns 10 points, not 15.

The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Additional Requirements To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

ENTRY AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules" and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the TFTCC has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these all-breed shows, obedience trials, agility trials or any of the associated Specialties, and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Toy Fox Terrier Club of Canada and associated Clubs, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
