Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

<u>Border Crossing</u>: Government regulations require that to be brought into Canada a dog must have a Rabies Certificate. The certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry in to the United States.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered.

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog **9 months of age and under 12 months of age** on the day of the show

<u>12 to 18 MONTH CLASS</u> – This class shall be for any dog **12 months of age and under 18 months of age** on the day of the show

<u>CANADIAN BRED CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/co- owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u> - Dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. The winners of each class in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

<u>SPECIALS ONLY CLASS</u> - Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required points for Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

<u>BABY PUPPY CLASS</u>- This class shall be for any dog 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed.

BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) Any dogs entered in brace MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only on the same day

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

<u>Stud Dog and Get</u> - This class shall be comprised of the stud dog and two (2) or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a regular class.

Brood Bitch and Progeny - This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get class. (The brood bitch may be spayed.)

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Best Ridge – Judge TBA, free entry. To be judged on the completion of all official events. This event will be divided by sex, then an overall winner will be chosen.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

Judge (all classes): Saturday August 6, 2022. Before the start of the specialty.

Classes will be divided by Sex and Age:

4-6 months of age/6-9 months of age / 9-12 months of age / 12-18 months of age

Rosettes will be awarded to First in each class, Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex. Flat ribbons will be awarded to 2nd, 3rd and 4th in each class. Best in Sweepstakes will receive a 50% of total entry fees collected, Best of Opposite 25% of total fees collected. Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex will be chosen from the Class winners. Remainder 25% will be retained by the Club to defray costs. To enter sweepstakes, the dog must be entered in one of the regular/non-regular classes or in Exhibition Only on Saturday August 6, 2022.

TROPHY and AWARD LIST

Rosettes are offered for the following:

Best in Specialty, Best Puppy in Specialty, Best Baby Puppy in Specialty, Best Veteran in Specialty, Best Canadian Bred, Best Brood Dog/Progeny, Best Stud Dog/Get, Best Brace in Specialty, Best of Winners, Winners, & Reserve Winners, and Best Ridge.

Suitable prizes (in addition to the ribbons) for:

BOB, BOS, BOW, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy In Breed, Winners Male, & Winners Female.

<u>Award of Merit</u>: This award will be made after the Best of Breed judging. An Award of Merit will be awarded for every 10 dogs competing at Best of Breed level.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The point system provides for additional points if a class dog awarded Best of Breed also places in the group as listed below;

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall not be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

15.2 Grand Champion (GCh) (47-06-12)

- 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.
- 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship. All required points are to be earned at the breed level.
- 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.15.2.4 The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.
- (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

- 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.
 - (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
 - (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
 - (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five
- 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.
 - (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. - 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.
 - (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
 - (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title. 15.3.2 Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC Conformation Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Conformation Championship.
- 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)

- 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.
- 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:
 - (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed)
 - (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins.
 - (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles. (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (18-09-20) (18-09-20) (18-09-20) 55 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.
- **4.1.5** No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.
- 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
